again on Tuesday next with John Taylors Negroes to raise a crop  
with in Mr. I shall require of you as his commissioner Merchants  
about One Hundred Bales \$35 of it in specie

You have already rec<sup>d</sup> 48 Bales of his Cotton which I imagine  
has gone down the river to New Orleans. I learn there are 9  
more Bales at the Gin if they will bale out today some for 8  
more that is ginned, some more to pick out from the patch and to  
give enough to make 70 Bales in all or upwards

# John Taylor and myself talked together on the subject  
of instructing your Agent at New Orleans what disposition  
to make of the Cotton and came to the following conclusion  
that the Cotton should be sold at their discretion at any time  
during this Cotton season so as to insure the best price the  
market would afford this instruction you will please  
give them when you write them again. The Cotton will  
be sold for his benefit and the proceeds contracted by  
me for his interests. My son William visits your town  
to day to transact business for me. If it should become neces-  
sary for me to go to Huntsville before I leave for the State  
do so on Tuesday.
