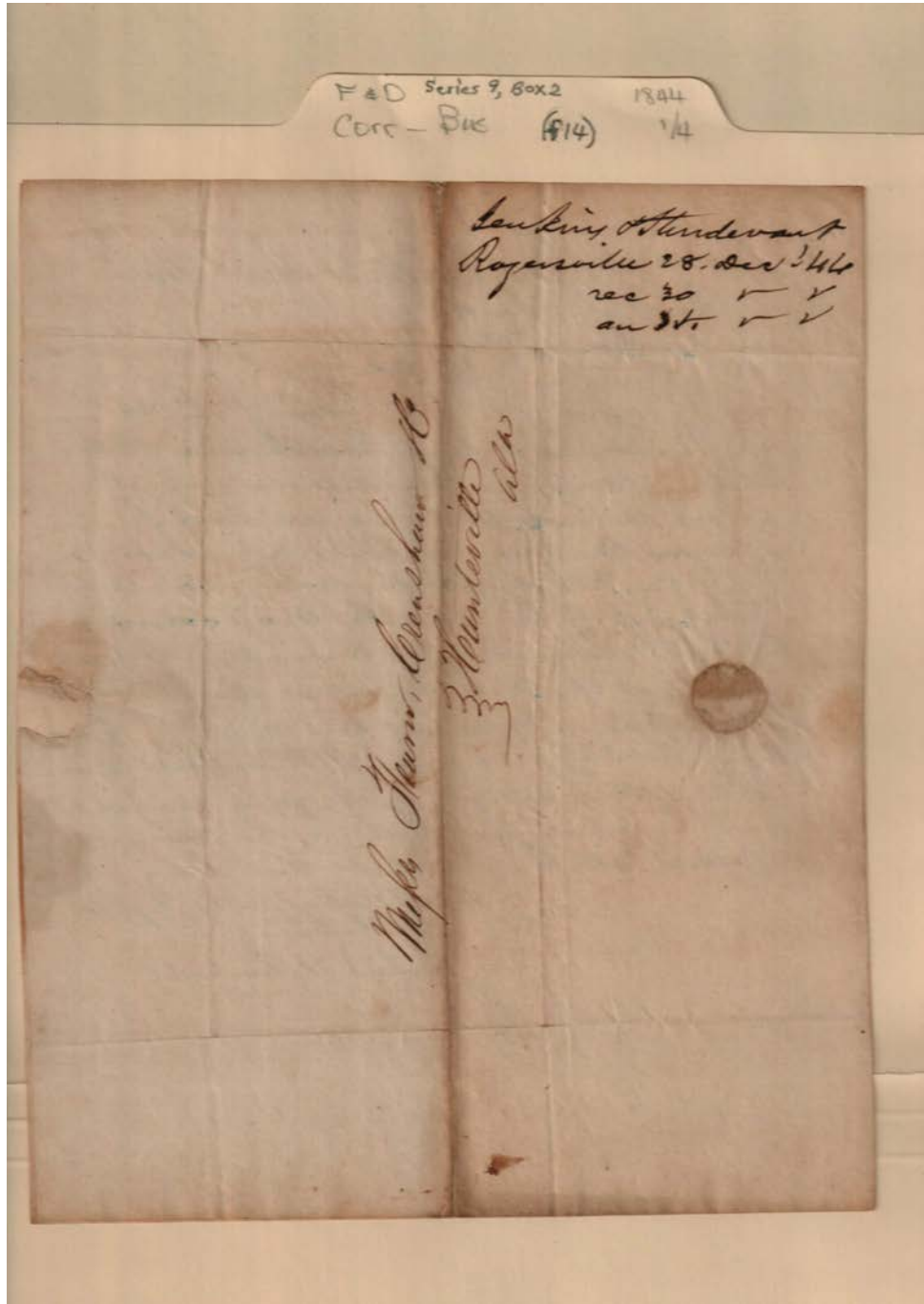

expect, to pay interest, on the money advanced,
but we still believe that we can continue at least
the amount you sent to Anderson, according to the
terms proposed - We presume you mean by "your
terms" the 2nd of advancing, and not your terms
in N.C. for storage, selling &c. If the funds you sent
cannot be entirely put to use, in the manner
proposed, it will be returned in due time.

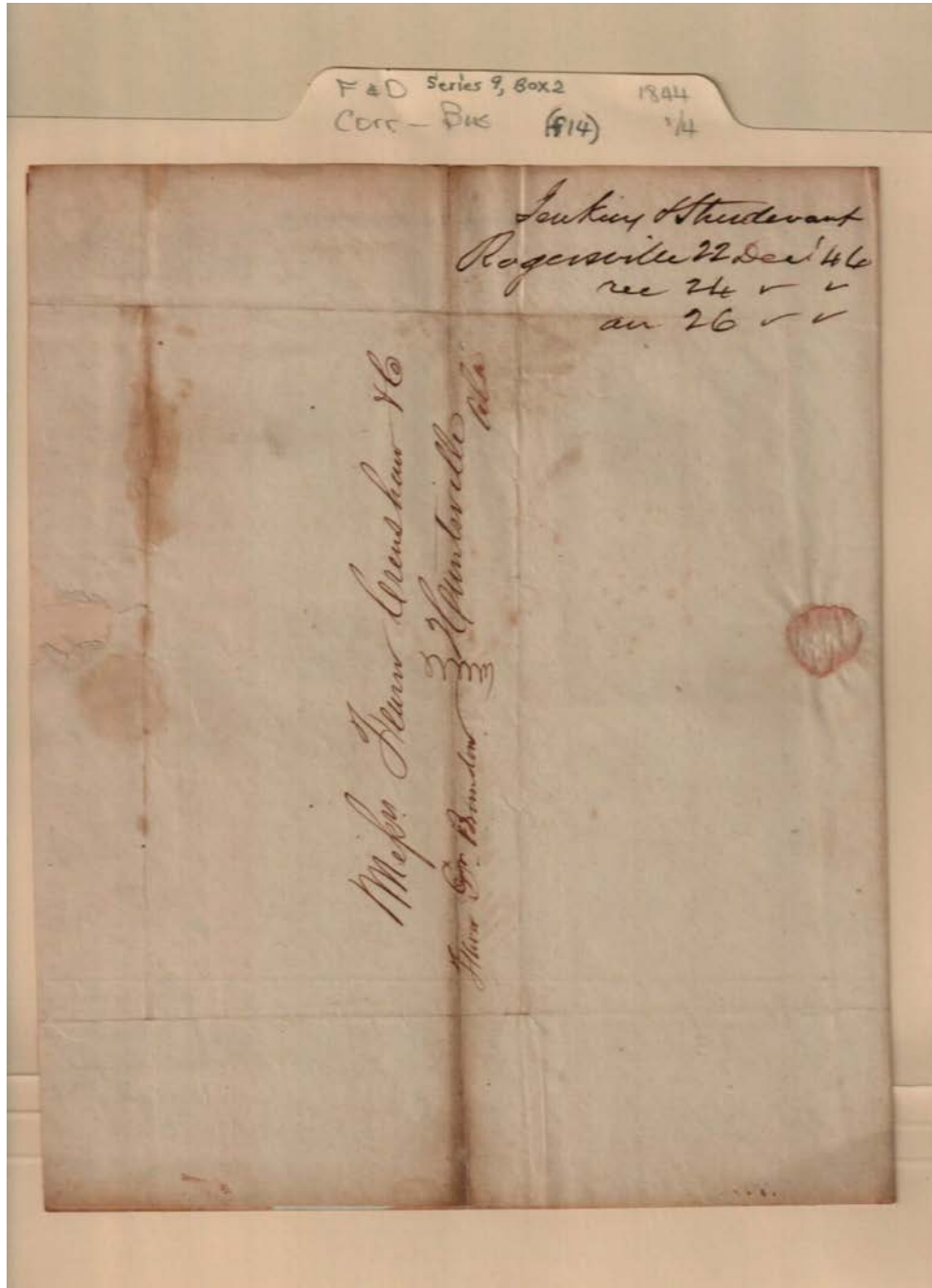

Gentlemen

Our Mr. Sturdivant, intended to
have visited Huntsville, for the purpose of
seeing you, on the subject of Cotton, but could
not conveniently do so, having other engagements
to attend to, we therefore in reply to yours of
the 13th instant, informed you that we have made
arrangements with some of our farmers, to ship
about 250 Bales of Cotton, in the manner
proposed, this quantity will be ready, and
ready for shipment by the first rise of water.
We think that at least 1 or 200 bales more, may
be contracted, in like manner, but they say,
they cannot advance us until their Cotton, is
ready for market. In yours of the 13th you
did not mention any thing, in relation to what
we the money advanced, but we took it for
granted, that you did, intend charging any
thing for advancing no interest, on the amount,
and made our Contract, accordingly; that the
amount was 3rd per cent. after paying charge 1st would
be paid them in good funds - We would therefore
ask you, to send a sufficient amount of funds, to
advance on the contract of Cotton (viz) 250 Bales

to you for proposing to let us keep it two or three weeks if we could
it but we hope to be able to get along without it. and you
might have an opportunity of using it yourself. as our funds
it is getting in demand so that there will be no difficulty
in using money in the way you state. that is getting most
pleas found with interest - there has been a con-
siderable quantity of cotton sold in this County at
from 6 to 70¢ mostly 62. I do not know what con-
cern it is purchasing some articles concern I presume
as the money comes from there. there are several agents
in this County I suppose some 2000. or 3000. bales have
been sold. there is more selling with the last few days as
they are now offering only 6 cts. - the operation has been
some advantage to us as it has thrown down money into
our community and greatly reduced the rate of exchange.

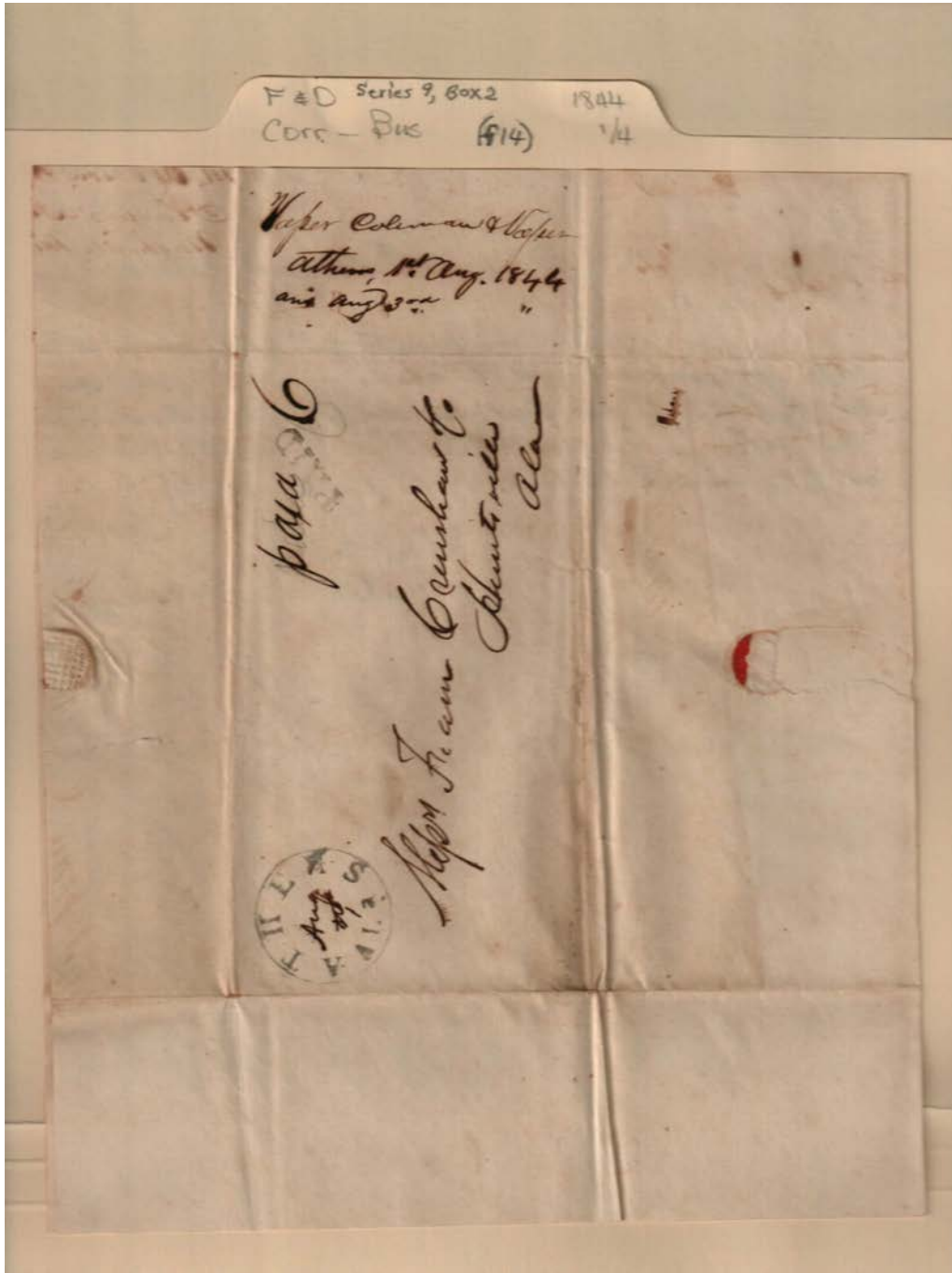

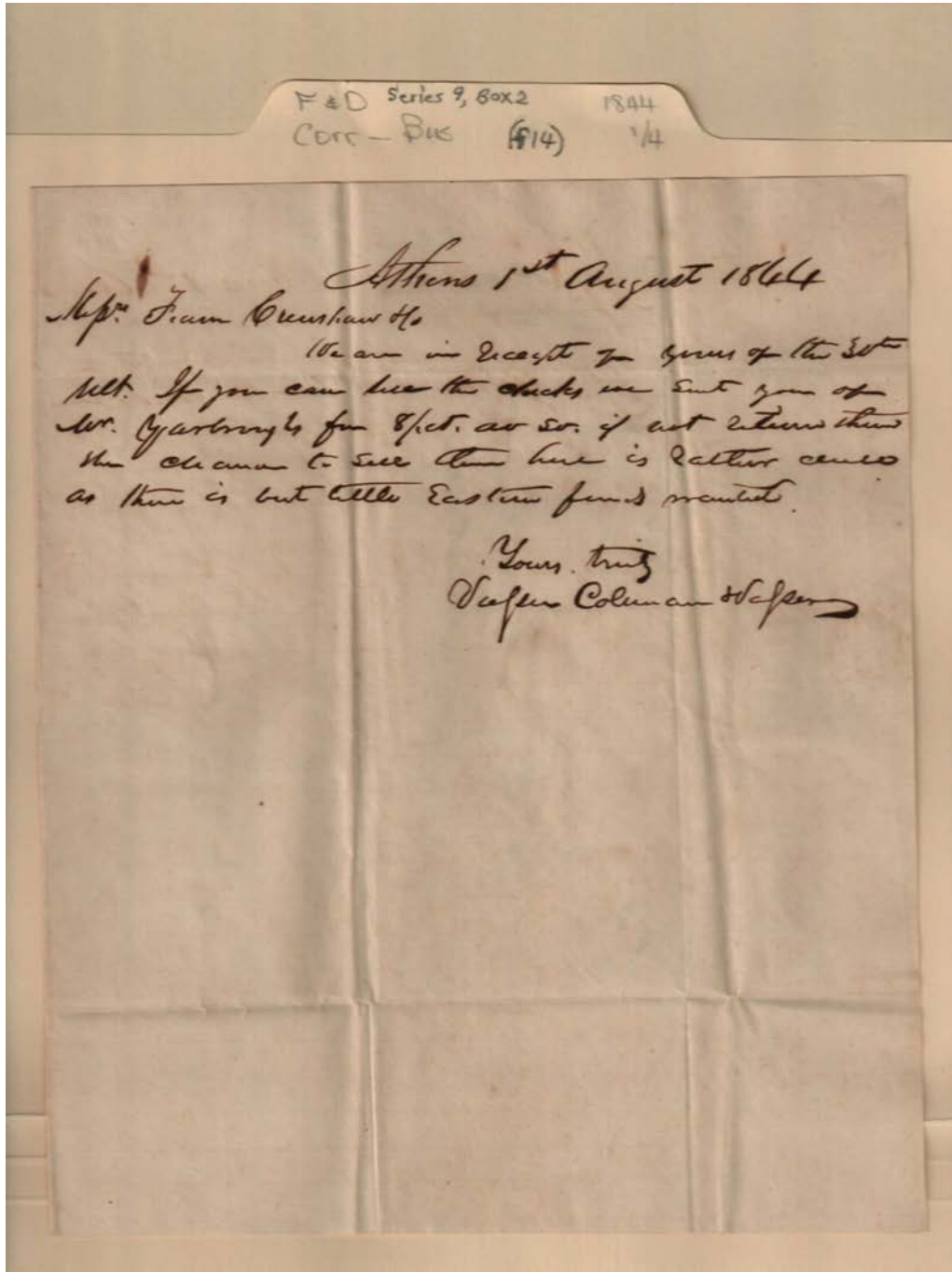

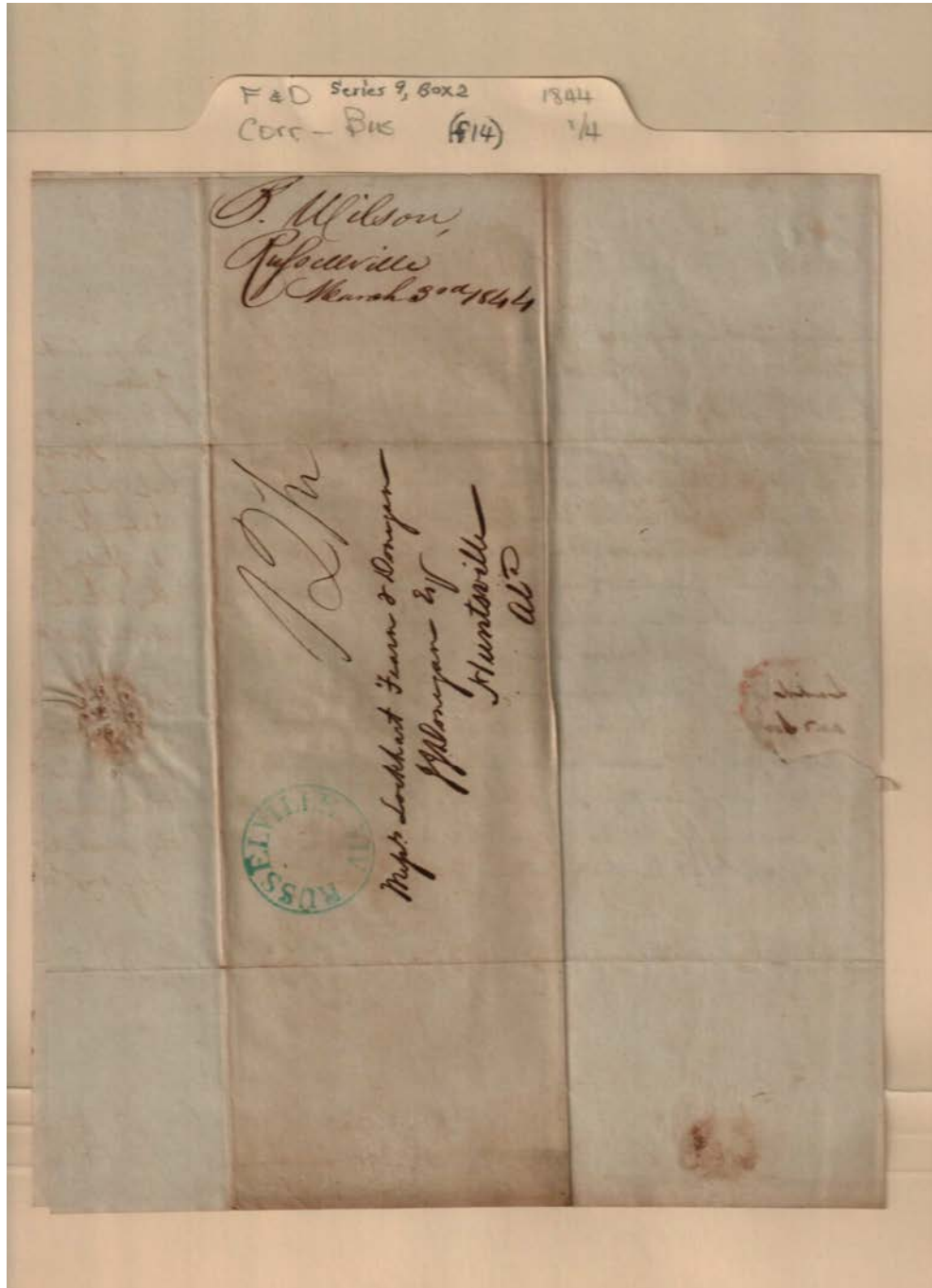

After the recd of your letter of 28 ult. I called upon
Col. W. B. Ladd and asked him for payment of the balance due
you. He replied that he had placed the notes upon you in the hands
of Judge Henry C. Jones for collection and as soon as your collector
indubitably your claim should be satisfied. I have been informed
by Judge Jones since, that at the term of our present Court just past
he obtained judgment in favor of Col. Ladd for Ten or Eleven Hundred
Dollars, all or the greater portion of which he expected to collect.

You are in error as to the notes against Col. Ladd being in my possession. I never saw it. For the Three Hundred
and Seventy Five Dollars remitted to your brother Mr. Wilson on the 17th ult.
1842. I gave Col. Ladd a rec. against the notes that being understood
to be among the papers of the late P. O'Reilly dec'd. I enquired of P. O'Reilly
this morning if he had found it among his late brother's papers: His
reply was that he had not.

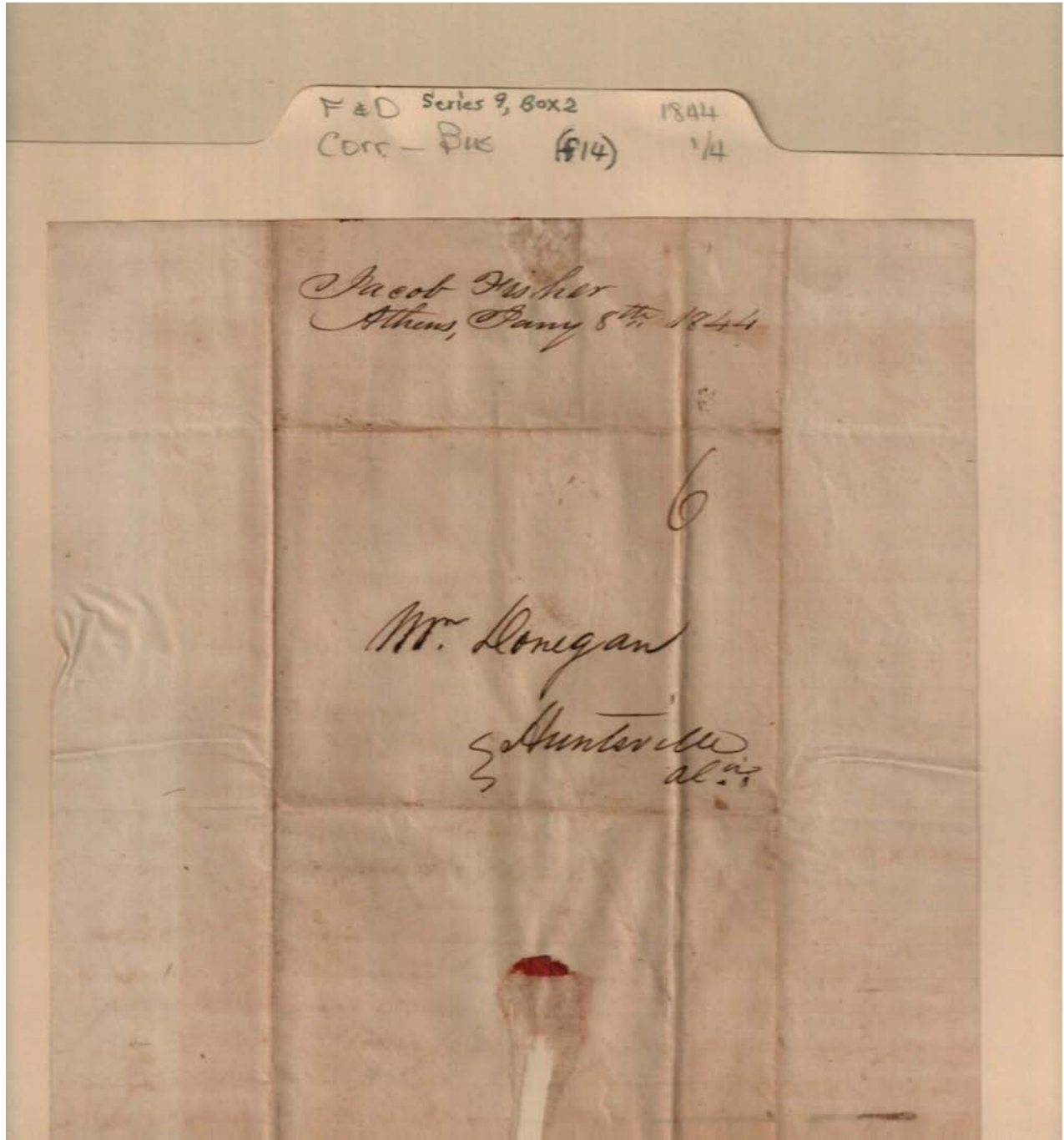

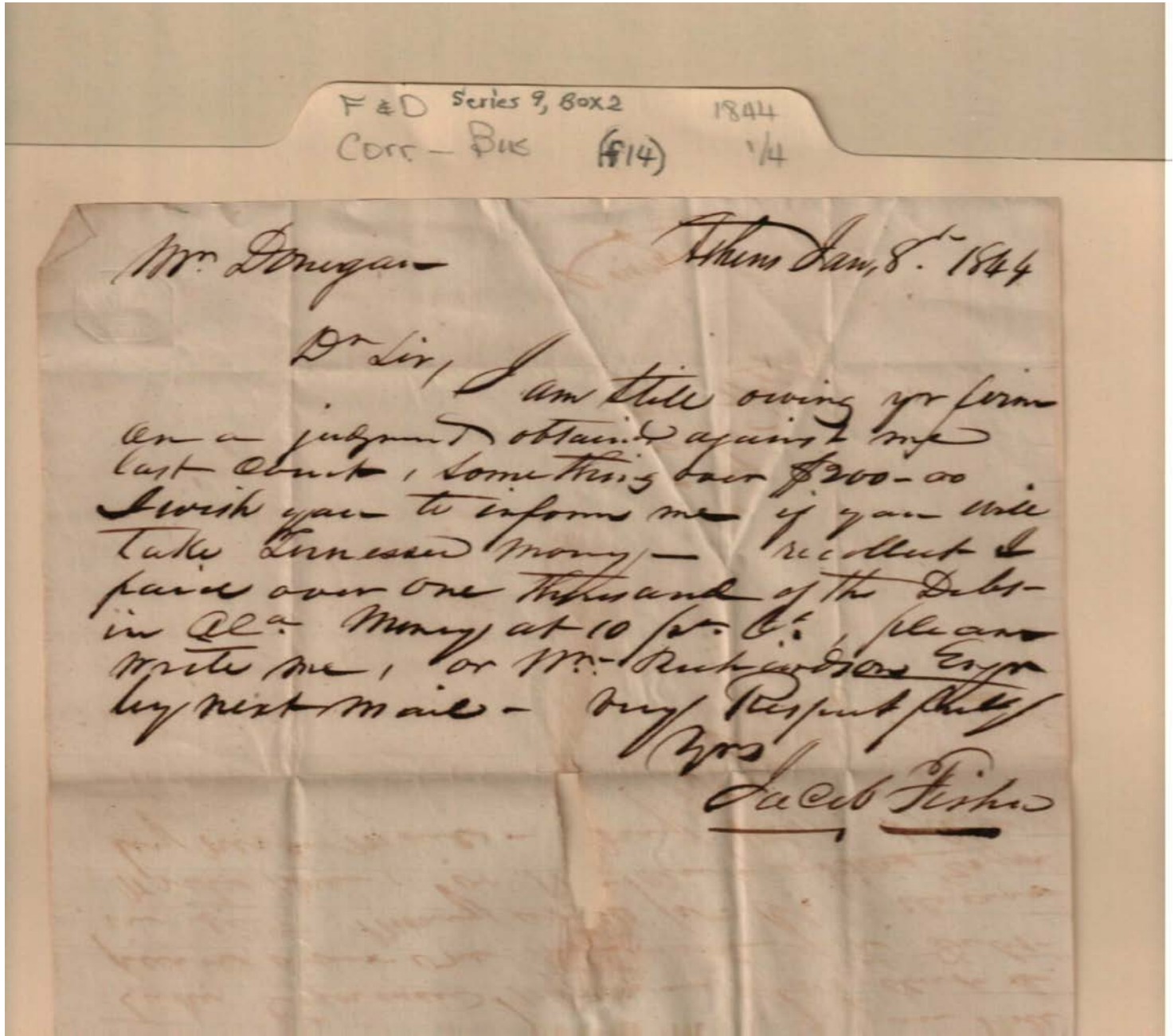

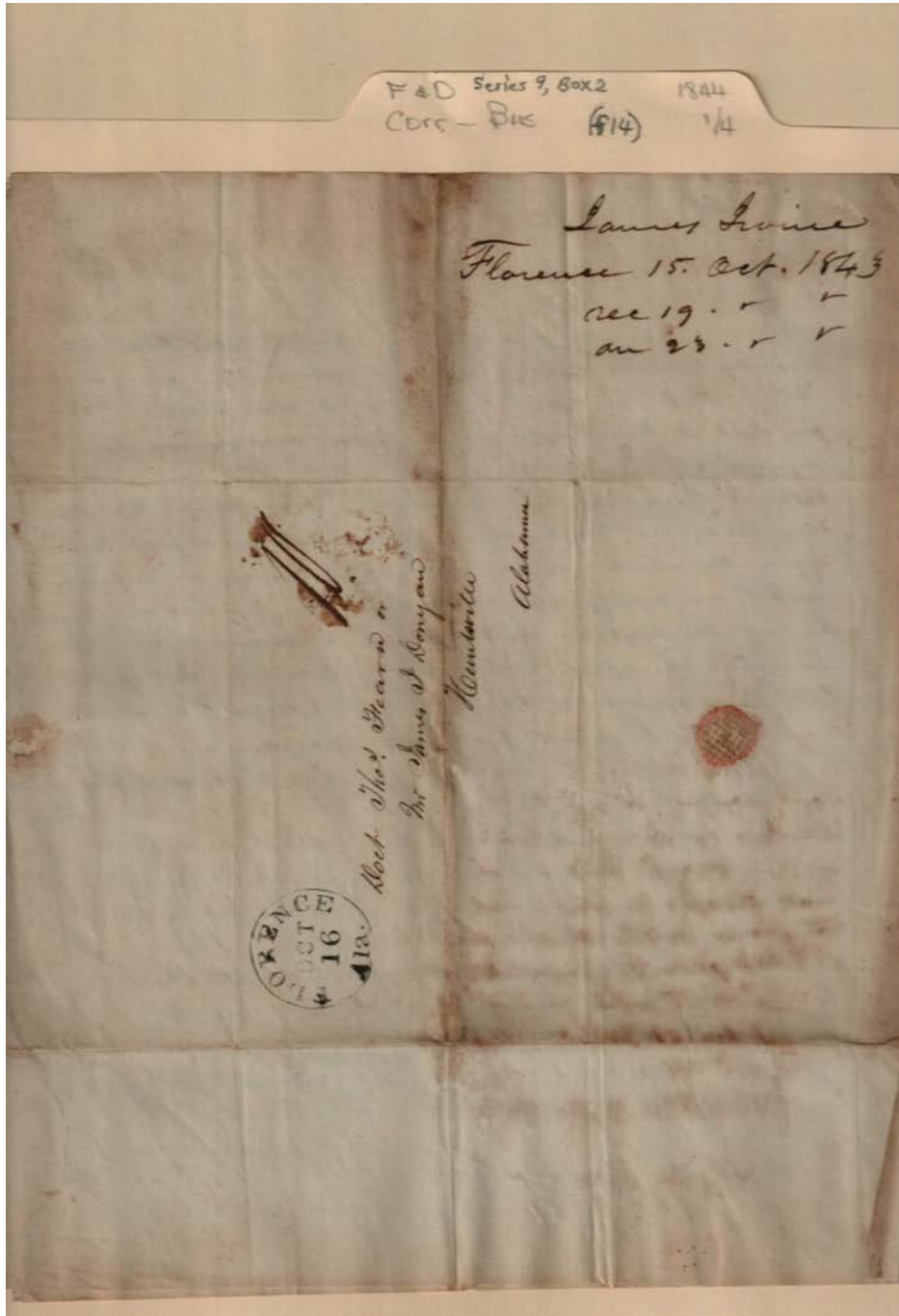

You will remember that when the Canal broke, it was necessary to raise funds to repair it immediately. James Weakly, Thos. J. Foster and myself to obtain funds made a vote of 2000 Dollars for stock at the Hotchkiss, but before the paper was discounted we required a guarantee for at least a part, that guarantee was obtained through you to the extent of 1000 Dollars and the vote was then offered and discarded. The work was in fact commenced before the stock was had, but after this money was obtained it was pushed as rapidly as in the Com^{rs} power, before it was completed however the legislature met, to whom a memorial was presented for means to repair to the extent of 10000 Dollars, but if not granted them to allow against this loan as it belonged to the State. The legislature paid no attention to the application and the Com^{rs} were in consequence obliged to abandon the work. The debt against us stood unpaid hoping the Com^{rs} hoping that the legislature would consider it their duty, but the present board are not inclined to wait they have brought suit and the suit has been served on me; something must therefore be done, and if the bank will not withdraw the suit and give us another chance with the legislature, I must request you to collect from the guarantors the 1000 Dollars with interest, and the three Com^{rs} Com^{rs} under carrying the balance. Messrs Weakly & Foster are not here at present - having been at Hotchkiss and I have to represent all. Are you representatives and try if you can collect them on the subject. I shall try any.
