I expected to have seen Mr Donegan on his way up but was sick at the time he passed here. As I shall need the money before I shall be in Huntsville I would be glad you would hand the amount due me to Dr Wm B. Dunn if he is there, if not you will please send it down by some other safe hand or by mail. I borrowed some time since from Mr Donegan \$75.00 in Ala money for which he has my Note.

 if it is entirely convenient to you say for a few weeks ago.  
 if at all as there is some demand now for cash a cotton  
 arrangement but we may be able to collect fast enough  
 to supply demand - but it is not convenient to do so  
 in that way until after 1<sup>st</sup> January - If you are  
 not in want of the use of the money you  
 will say so - do not hesitate to say so if you send  
 it there is a pretty amount there here in the cotton  
 market. there are some agents here purchasing at  
 6 1/2 cwt by all in Low. money we do not know who the  
 cotton is purchased for - a good many planters are  
 selling some are unwilling to sell paper stuff  
 to taking that price.

Dear Donegan

Your acceptable favor of the 20<sup>th</sup> ult. was rec<sup>d</sup>. here a few days since, having been forwarded from Memphis to St. Orleans & thence here. No other intelligence has reached either me or the girls from home since we left there, except through the newspapers, hence you may infer how very acceptable yours was. The girls are now at home & well, I understand, but I have not seen them for about 10 days. My intention, as I wrote you, was, after disposing of them for a time, to make some excursions through the country; but the rain, which is now falling, has been almost unintermitted, & although I am nearly about as well as when I left home, I cannot venture to expose myself to a Wetting - Last week, in company with brother George, I went out to the neighbourhood of Raymond, from thence into the lower edge of Madison; called in my way on the Sivils, J. D. Peebles, J. P. Harrison & Mrs. P. Hart, besides some few others, unknown to you. From the observations I have been able to make, the business of this country is more under the control of the forwarding merchants, than at Memphis or any other place I have seen. The planter generally obtains some supplies of his merchant, & leaves to him the selection of a factor in St. Orleans. Further information will confirm or correct this view; but if not unnecessary, we shall be compelled to make some friends at Vicksburg. Here we have a valuable auxiliary in Richardson & Moore; but I shall endeavor to get some others. And believing my presence not very necessary at this time in St. O. I would like to go to Yazoo City, if the weather would admit of it. But I never have been

so much annoyed by rain & mud - Independent of the danger of a wetting, the roads are nearly impassable, & when in a town, particularly Vicksburg, where there are no side walks in many parts, & no crossings, I found it utterly impracticable to get about, & certainly most unreasonable to ask a friend to accompany you for the purpose of introducing you - Wagoners have ceased to come in with cotton, & the rail road is frequently impassable for the heavier cars, & the passengers get on by walking over the benches. The rivers - Big Black & Pearl can be passed, the former <sup>only</sup> by the cars, & the latter only over the embankment between this & Brandon, & that now impracticable for wagons - So you see, I am tied up - mud & water bound -

The effect of this continuance of bad weather is extremely unfavorable to the quantity & to the getting out of the crops. The estimate in this region is from 1/2 to 2/3 of last year's - some make not over 1/3 others two thirds. Believing the same state of things prevails to a greater or less degree over the whole cotton region, I am satisfied the estimate which they still seem to be making in N. O. of 1800000 bales is too much by ~~say~~ <sup>over</sup> 200000. Some of the dealers in the article at N. O. must have come also to this conclusion, from the "flare up" they have had there from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup> (my last date).

J. P. Harrison had assured G. Fearn before I saw him, that the debt of S. F. & Co. shall be paid by the 1<sup>st</sup> Inst. & he now says he has cotton enough to meet which shall go forward as soon as practicable. He has a very good plantation with a tolerable crop, & I hope will pay this season greater part if not all the debt - Mrs. Fort was not at home, but I made an agreement with her son in law - Rich. Ford - & signed & left with him for

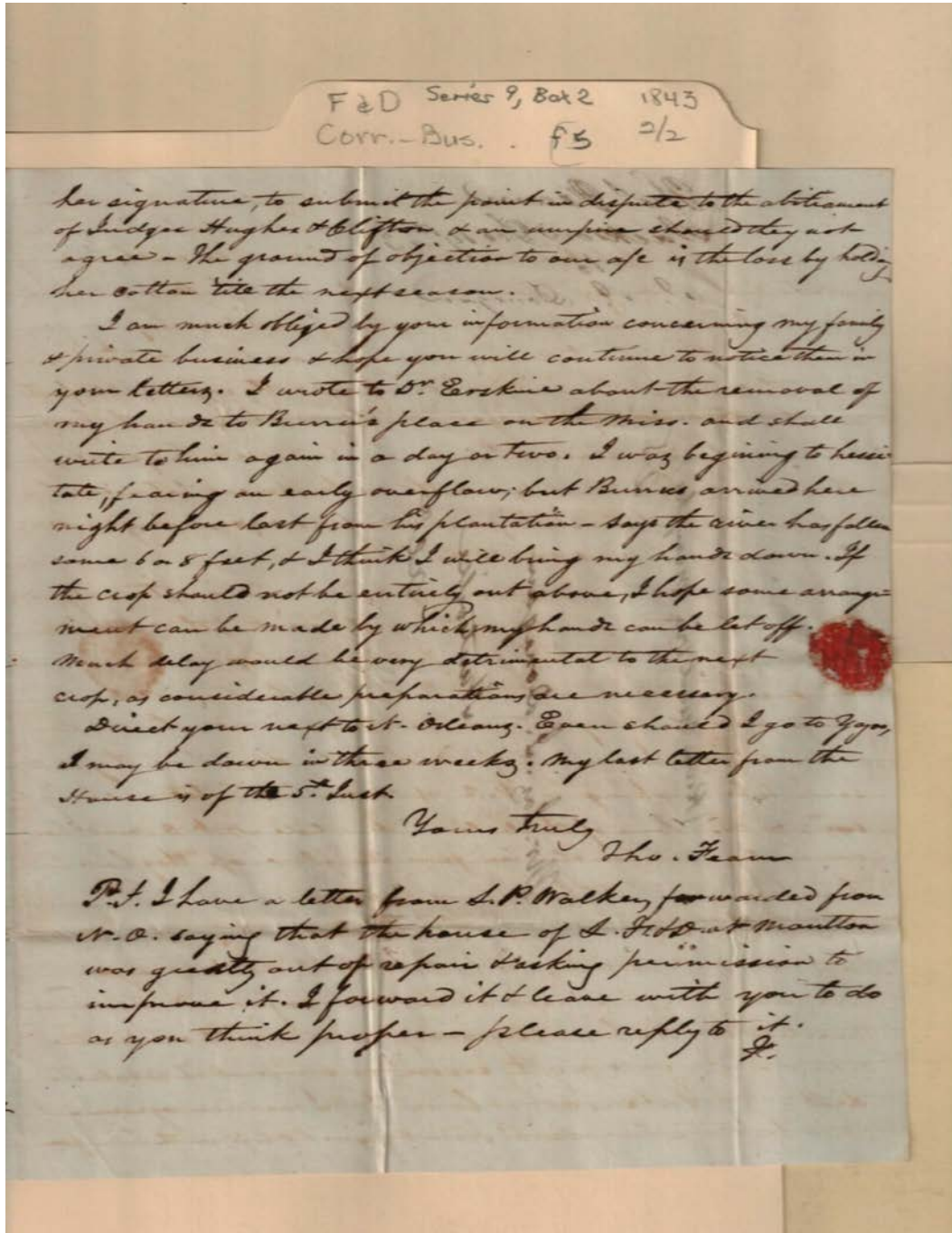

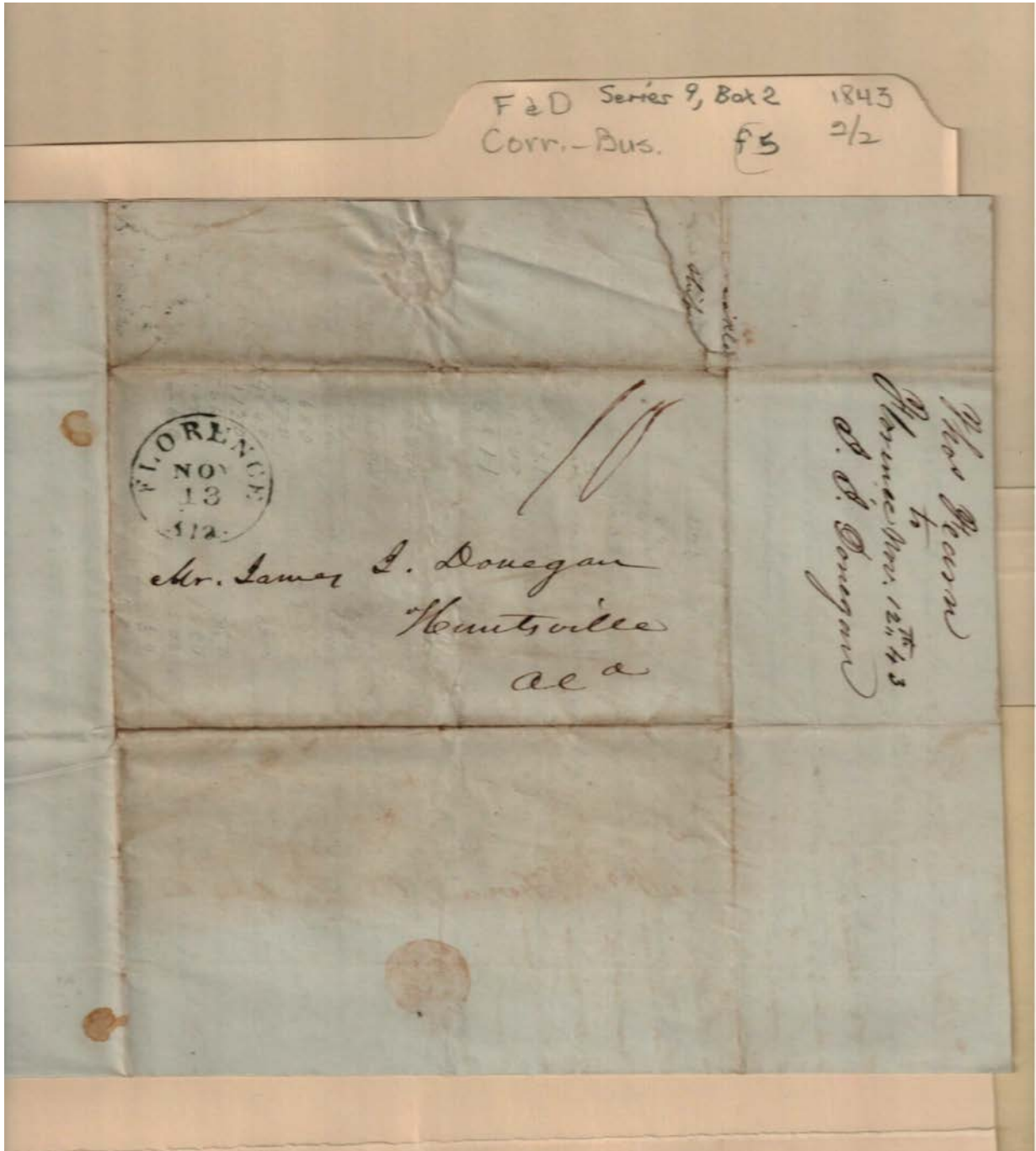

Finding some difficulty & getting a conveyance from Tusculum to this place for my girls & baggage, after seeing Barton & some few others there, I procured a horse & came over myself after dinner, returning again at night to come over at 4 o'clock this evening in the stage & be ready to proceed on in the morning. Barton this <sup>his</sup> business will not fall off from this point - There is a prospect of some accessions, and several here expressed to me the conviction of benefit from a visit by you in a short time & your sojourn a few days with them. Weakley thinks it would be well for you to come down and spend about a week at Florence during the special term of the Dist. Court, which commences Monday the 1st. You could spend a few days either before or after - better before if practicable here.

Barton has arranged with Patton & taken a check on St. Orleans for \$400 - which at his request has been held up for a few days - and a new bill for the balance - Both of which he is confident will be punctually met - Isaac Winston's of \$114.92 - 31. July '43 I left with Barton with written request, that the amt. should be paid over to him - W. B. Hogan is satisfied that a judgment should be had against him for his debt & damages; but requests that the execution shall not be put in the hands of the Marshal for 40 days, as his cousin informs him 20 bales of Cotton have been shipped to pay, & the balance shall follow in due time - I have promised it shall be done - please say so much to Parsons.

I have not been able to see Paobasco - he being absent but it is not material, as you will probably be down soon - (North in Patton)

Dear Sir,

I have just been inspecting your house and lot in this place, preparatory to taking possession, and confess myself somewhat surprised to find it so "out of order" for a residence, there was a hole in any door in the house, shutty pane glass out, one sash entirely gone, one half of the roof full of leaks and affording every rain sufficient notice for good holiness, disfigured baptisms, a noble piece torn down, a terrible aperture in the wall sufficiently large to admit friend "Solus" sans ceremony, the garden feeling all "tattered and torn" with many other grievances of a like nature and kind. In its present condition no man would rent without leave to repair, and it is too good a house to "turn upon the corner". I shall take possession and do such repairs and no more, as are necessary to keep out wind and rain, and prevent the house from sinking into pre-mature decay, with the understanding that it is to be dedicated out of the rental. 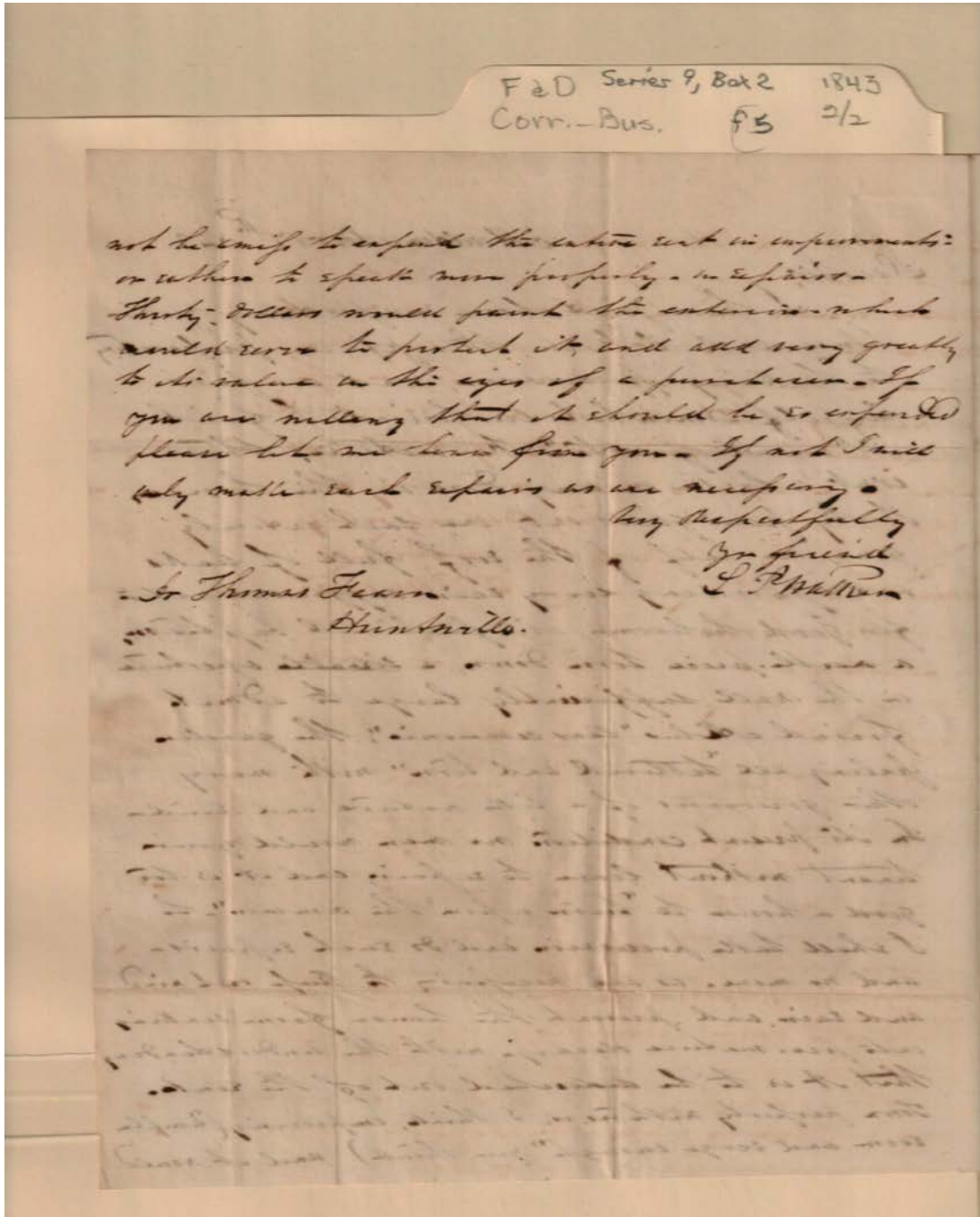
