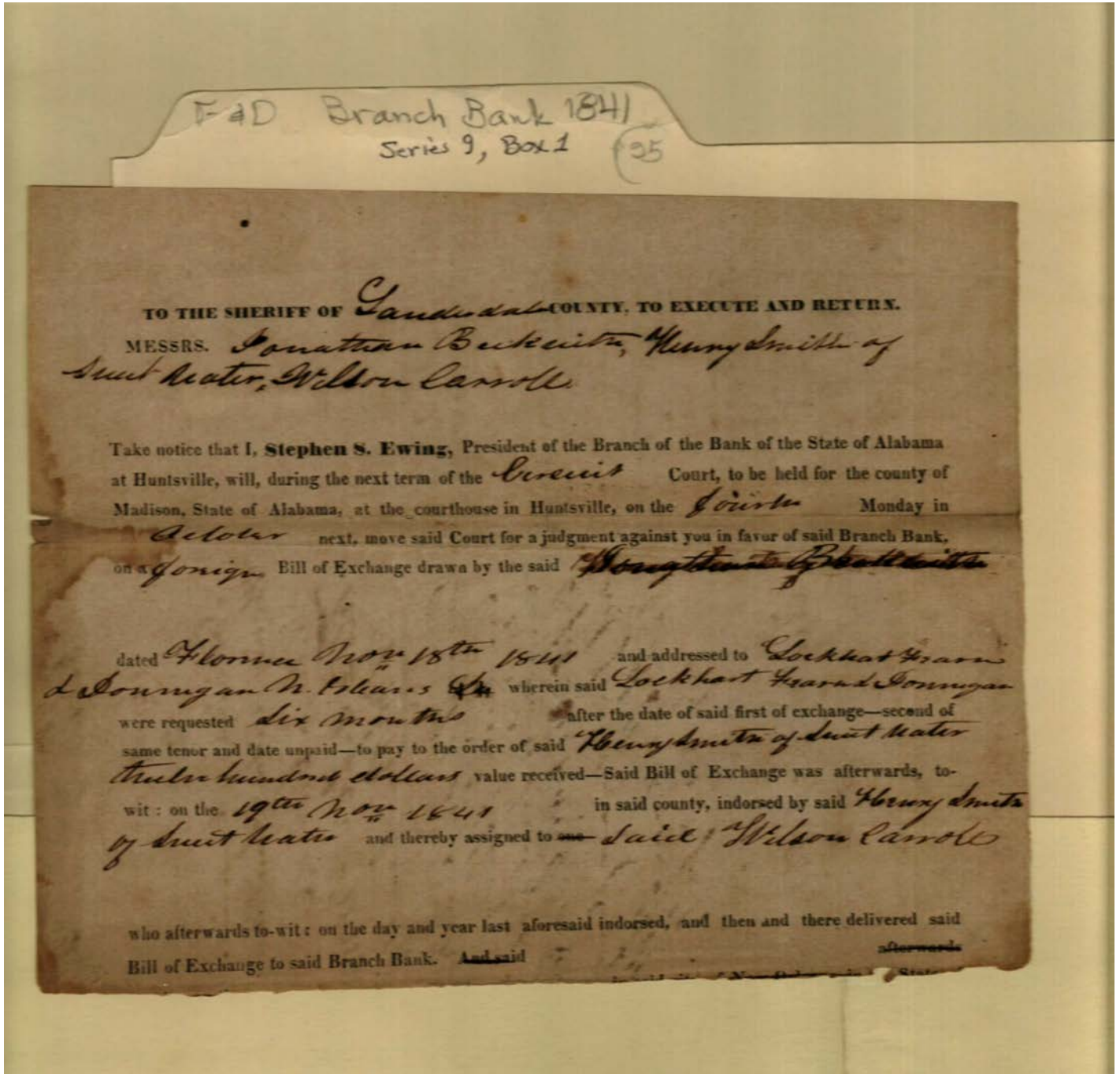

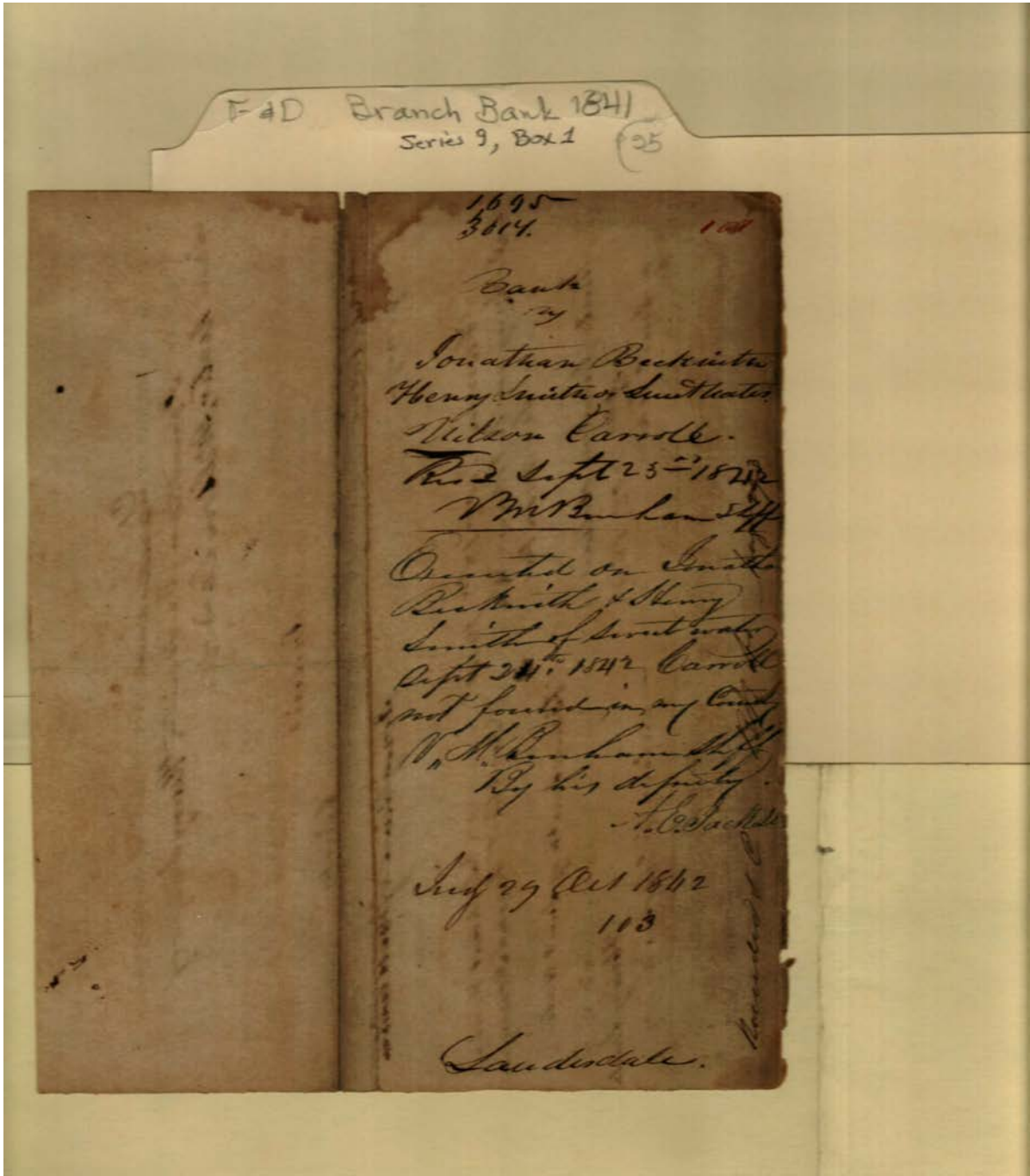

TO THE SHERIFF OF *Madison* COUNTY, TO EXECUTE AND RETURN.
MESSRS. *George Wilkinson Samuel Blackwell*
William H. Blackwell

Take notice that I, *Stephen S. Ewing*, President of the Branch of the Bank of the State of Alabama at *Huntsville*, will, during the next term of the *Circuit* Court, to be held for the county of *Madison*, State of Alabama, at the courthouse in *Huntsville*, on the *fourth* Monday in *October* next, move said Court for a judgment against you in favor of said Branch Bank, on a *foreign* Bill of Exchange drawn by the said *George Wilkinson*

dated *Virginia 21st Decr 1841* and addressed to *Lockhart Fearn & Donegan* wherein said *Lockhart Fearn & Donegan* were requested *six months* after the date of said first exchange—second of same tenor and date unpaid—to pay to the order of said *Samuel Blackwell* *Twenty hundred dollars* value received—Said Bill of Exchange was afterwards, to-wit: on the *10th Decr 1841* in said county, indorsed by said *Samuel Blackwell* and thereby assigned to *Said William H. Blackwell*

who afterwards to-wit: on the day and year last aforesaid indorsed, and then and there delivered said Bill of Exchange to said Branch Bank. ~~_____~~
to-wit: on the _____ at the city of *New Orleans* State of *Louisiana*

The said Bill of Exchange at the maturity thereof, to-wit: on the *Thursday 1st Jan 1842* was presented and shewn to said *Lockhart Fearn & Donegan* at the counting house in said city of *New Orleans*, and payment thereof demanded, which was then and there refused, whereupon the same was then and there duly protested for non-payment, of which the said *George Wilkinson Samuel Blackwell William H. Blackwell* then and there last aforesaid had notice.

The said Bill of Exchange being still wholly due and unpaid, a motion will be made ~~_____~~ against you the said *George Wilkinson Samuel Blackwell William H. Blackwell* for the sum of *Twenty hundred dollars* with interest, costs of protest, damages, and costs of this motion.
