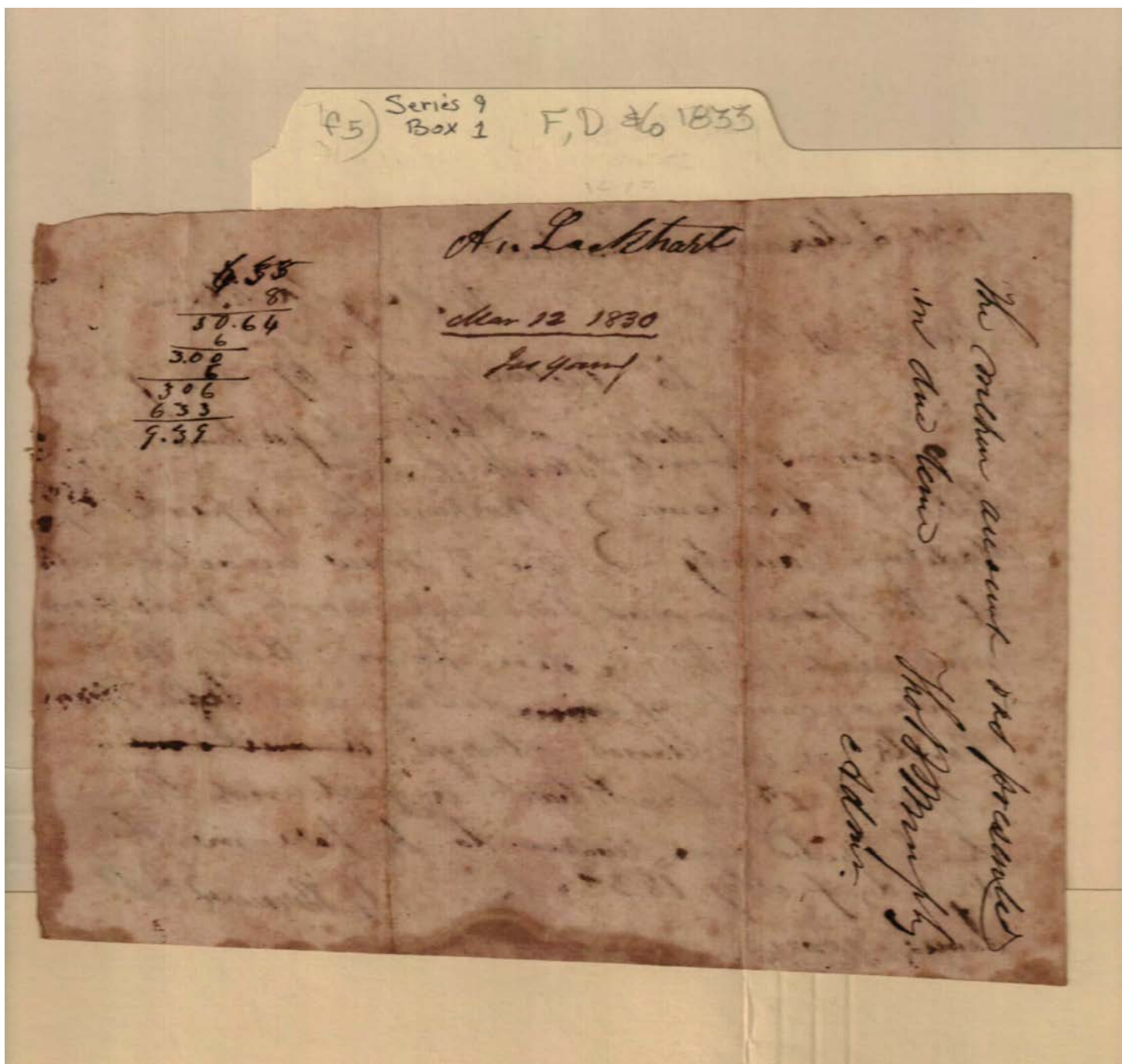

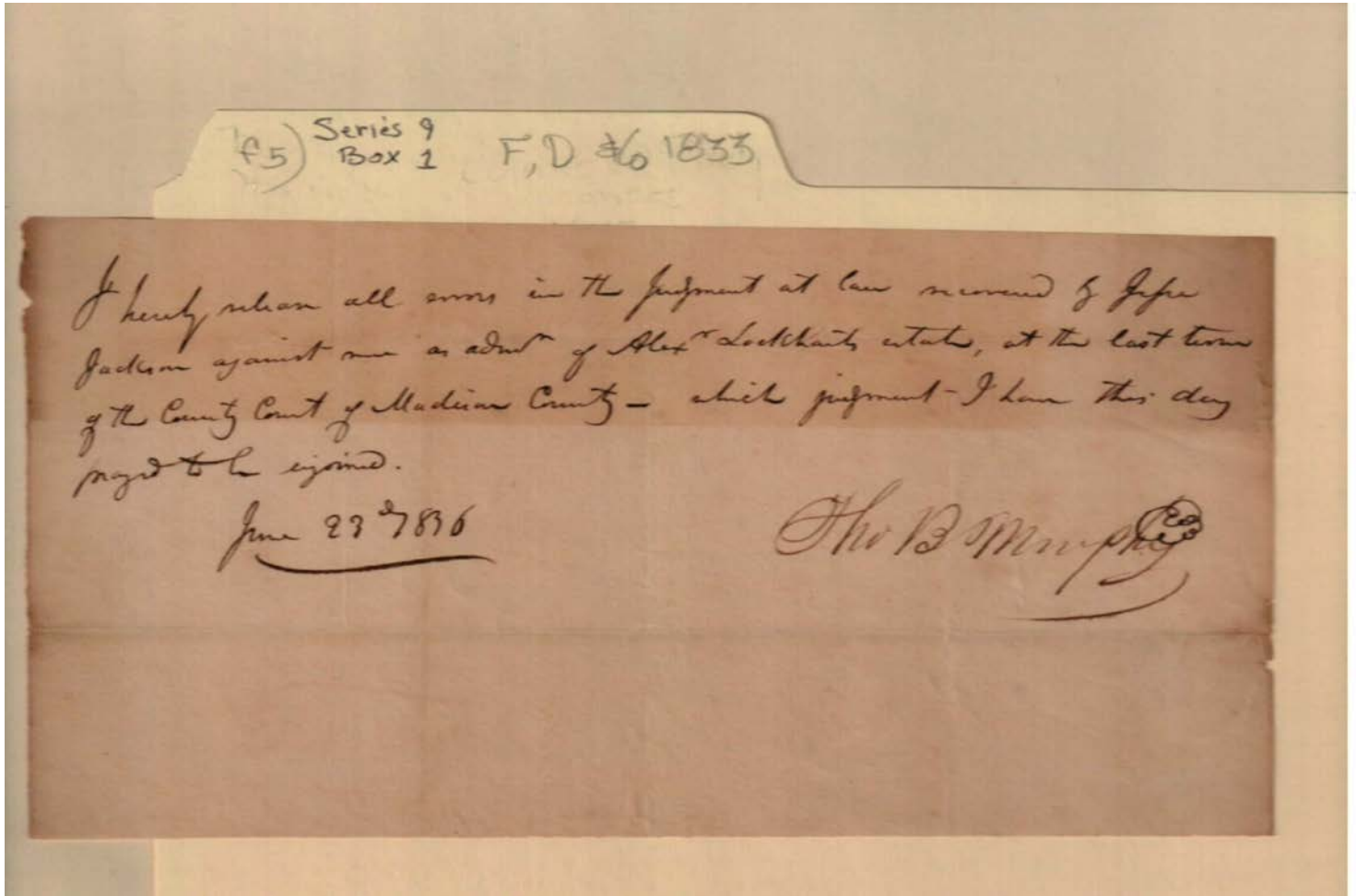

on the first of January 1833 & said
Lockhart refused to give possession
of said Hotel but in law
thereof paid me ^{the} S. D. Ross ninety
dollars without the consent or
approbation of the S. D. Jackson
he being dissatisfied

30th May 1833.

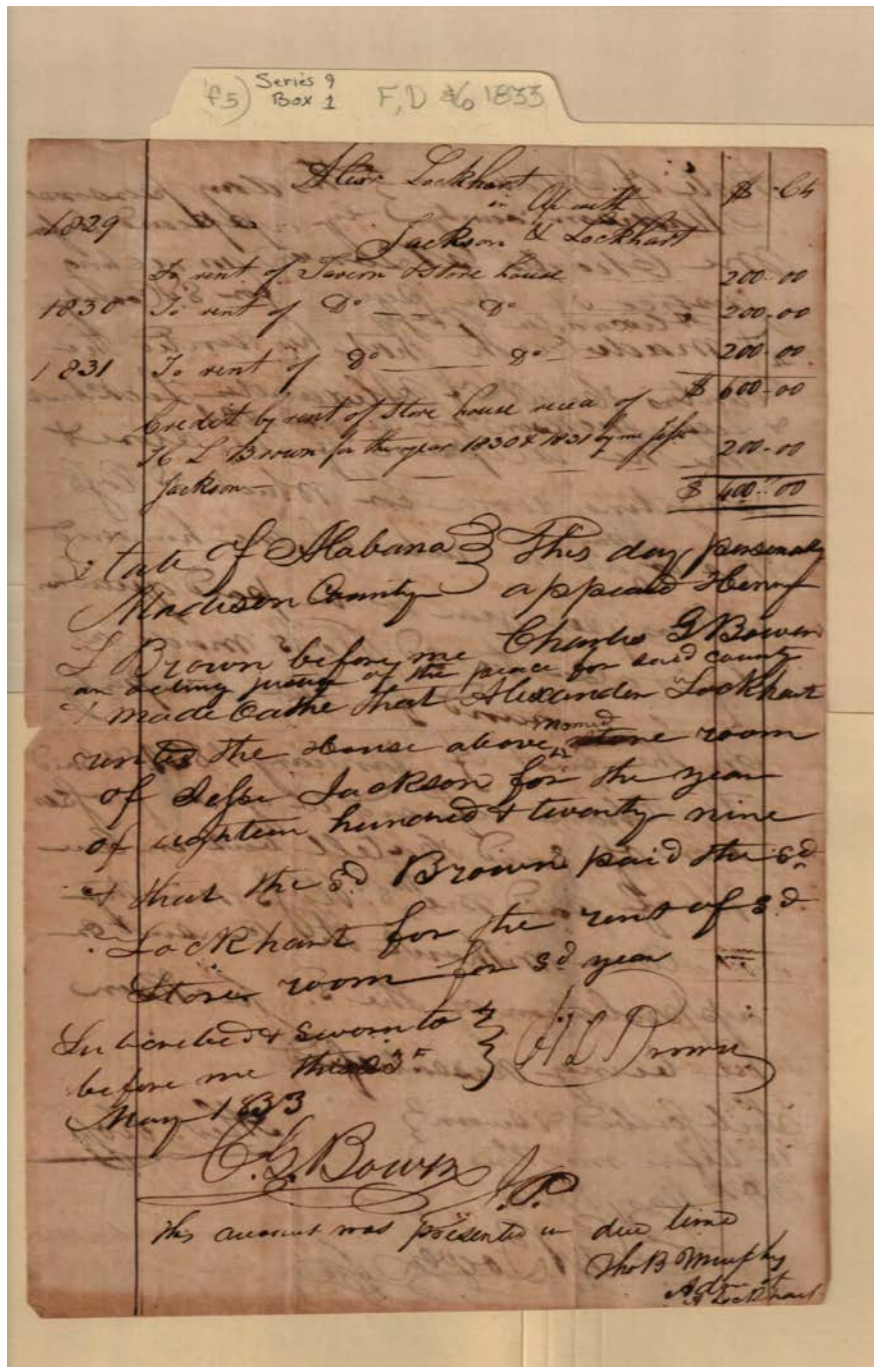
