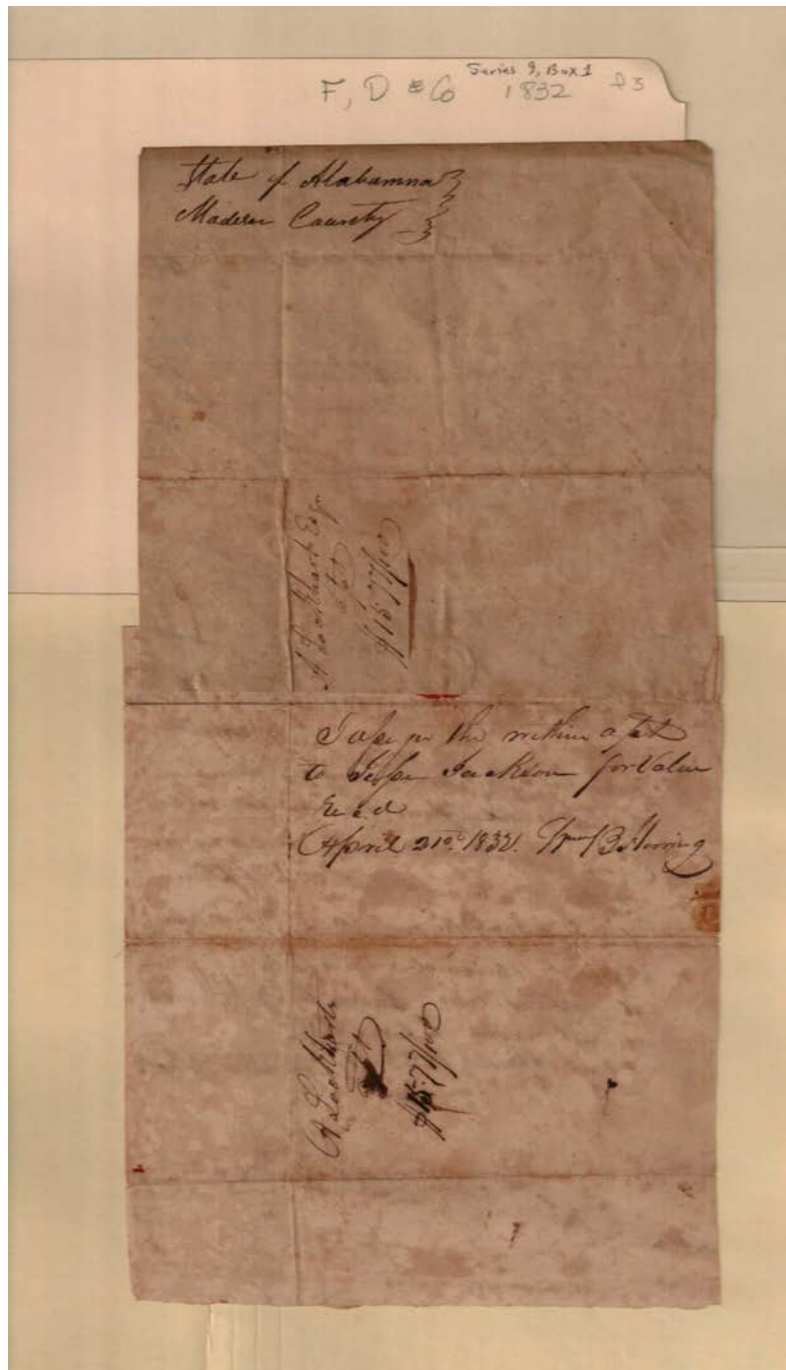

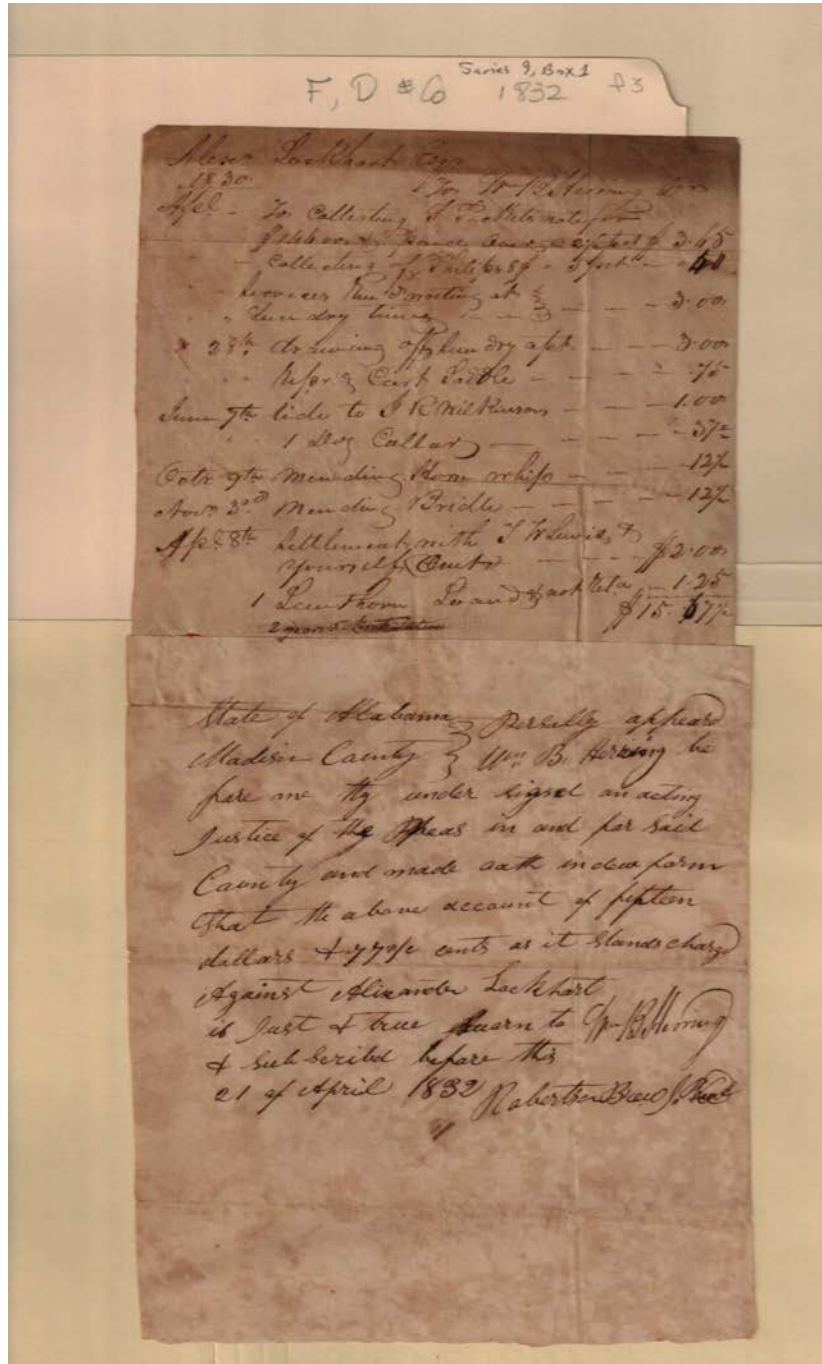

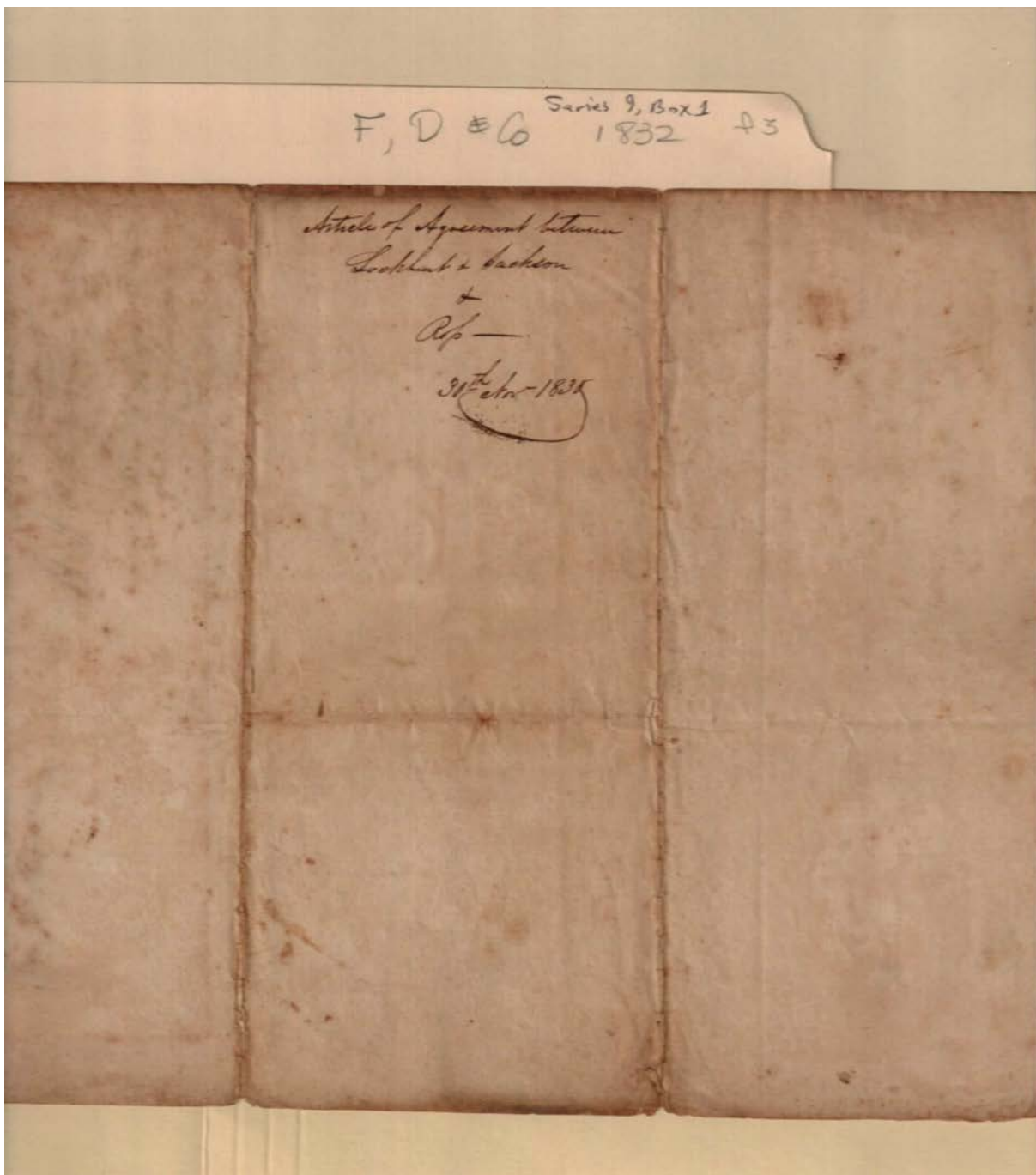

An article of agreement made and entered into this 30th  
November 1830 between Alexander Lockhart and Jesse Jackson  
of the one part and Miss Anna Rip of the part <sup>other</sup> all of the  
Town of Triana County of Madison & State of Alabama  
Wetumpka

That the said Lockhart and Jackson  
have this day rented to the said Rip the tavern house  
known as the Planters House together with the lot and  
building, thereto appertaining <sup>and</sup> the exception  
of the storeroom and counting room now occupied  
by Henry L Brown for the term of one year  
commencing on the first day of January Eighteen  
Hundred and thirty one and ending on the first  
day of January Eighteen Hundred and thirty  
two

That the said Lockhart and  
Jackson bind themselves to have the house  
so repaired as to keep it from leaking, to put  
a new sill under the dining room and also  
to have glass put in all the windows

The said Rip on his part agrees to  
pay the said Lockhart and Jackson the sum of one  
hundred Dollars quarterly in good accounts, <sup>to be paid</sup> ~~to be paid~~  
accounts coming due on or before the 1st of January 1832
