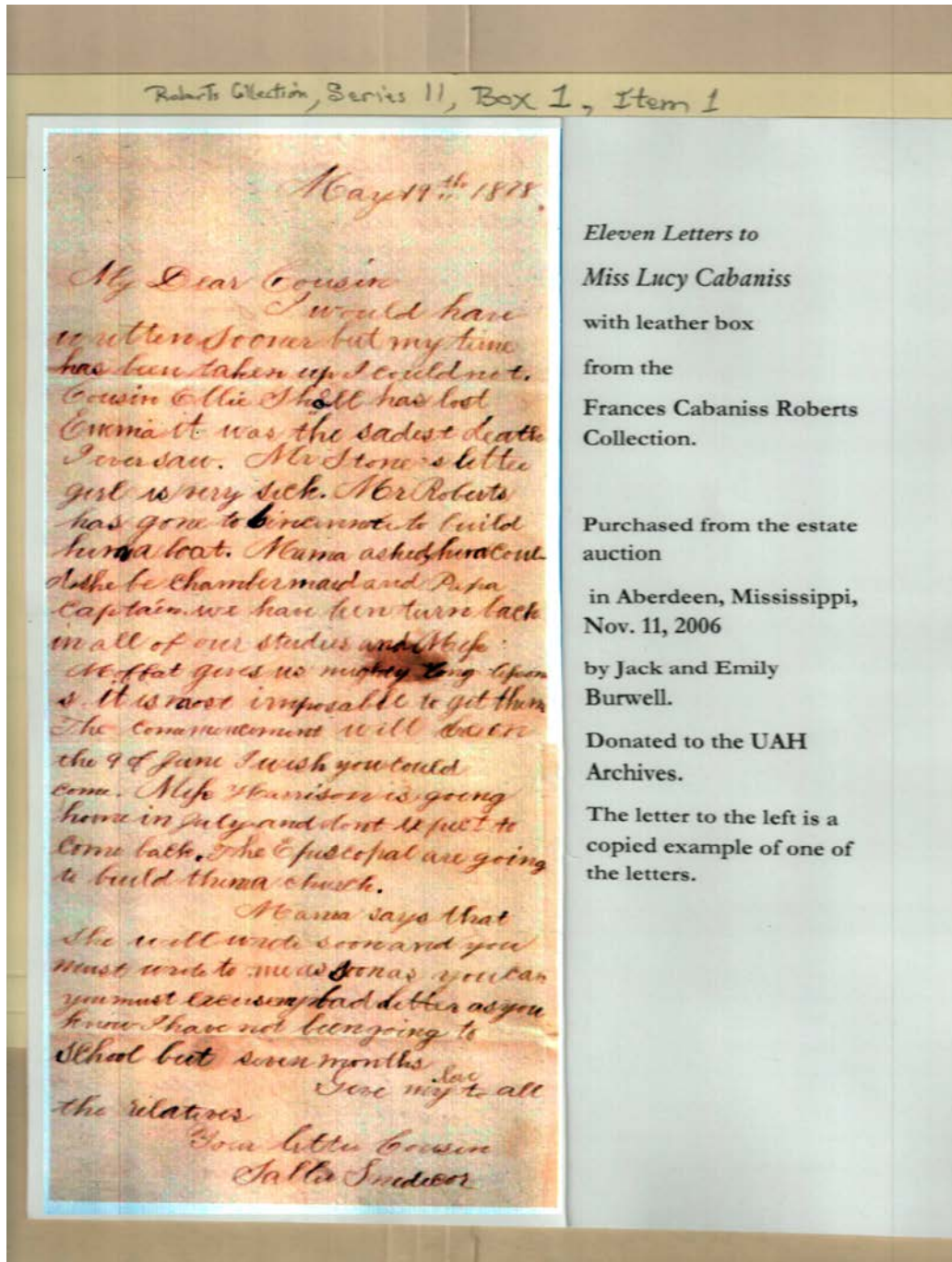

Dear Miss Lucy,

I take advantage of the present opportunity (as the gentleman in difficulties did when he walked out on Sunday), to write you a few lines to let you know that "I am well and doing well." And hope that you are enjoying the same blessing - "Salah." The paper you so kindly sent was duly received and read through and through. A thousand thanks are freely offered. And I will add that I'll offer ten or twelve thousand more for a letter from you. I'm just nearly crazy to hear from you. I tell you Miss Lucy that I think of you all the time. "There's not an hour of day or dreaming night but I am with you. There's not a wind but whispers of thy name. There's not a flower that sleeps beneath the moon but in its hues and fragrance tells a tale of thee." I wish you could have been here to the concert. It was real nice - I send herewith a programme.
