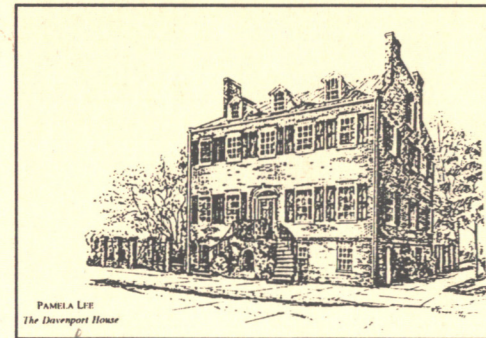


Historic Savannah Foundation, a non-profit, membership organization, holds as its principal charges the preservation of Savannah's architectural heritage, unique city plan and the education of its citizens and others about cultural history and restoration techniques. The Foundation was established in 1955 by a group of seven Savannah women who were concerned about the planned demolition of the Isaiah Davenport House for a parking lot. With the group's successful campaign, the Foundation launched its rescue and restoration program, saving over 1700 architecturally significant buildings.

The Foundation has remained a leader in the field of historic preservation. This has been accomplished both by the direct intervention of HSF and through the Foundation's efforts to raise the consciousness of the public at large to the great importance and significance of Savannah's architectural heritage. HSF was chartered "to acquire, preserve, develop, and restore sites, buildings, and the squares which are a part of the original plan of Savannah and to preserve neighborhood design in mass and scale and proportion as well as other structures of historical interest in and around Savannah..."



1997-1998 Nominations. According to the By-Laws of Historic Savannah Foundation, additional nominations to the Board of Trustees can be made by petition signed by at least 45 members of the Foundation. Petitions, with the nominee's consent, must be sent to the Chairman of the Nominating Committee at P.O. Box 1733, Savannah, GA 31402, not less than two weeks in advance of the Annual Meeting. The Nominating Committee will advise the members present at the Annual Meeting of the names of all the candidates nominated.
