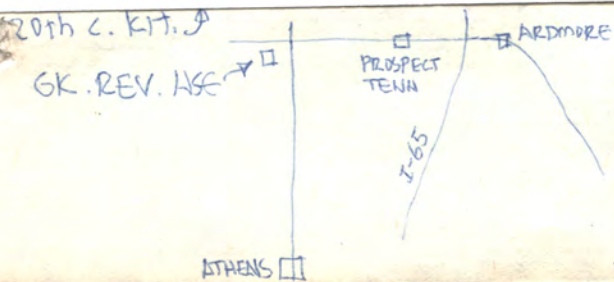

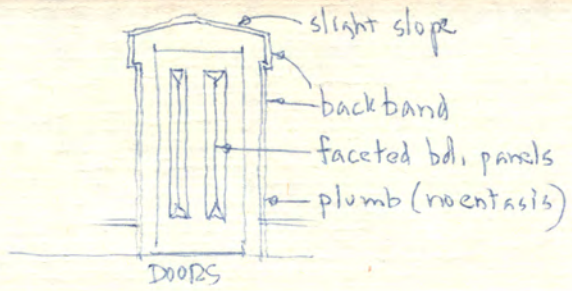

Stone Facing & Keystone



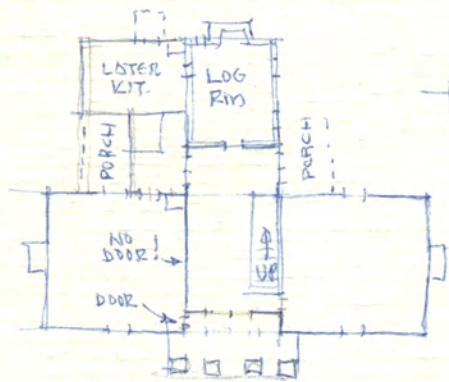
2nd fl. mantel (N. Rm)

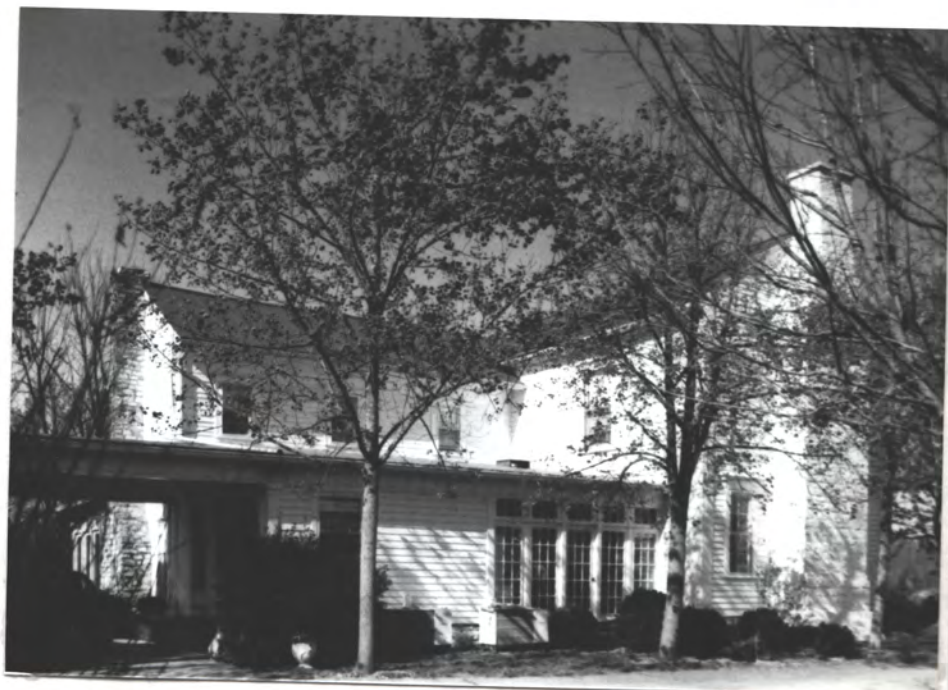

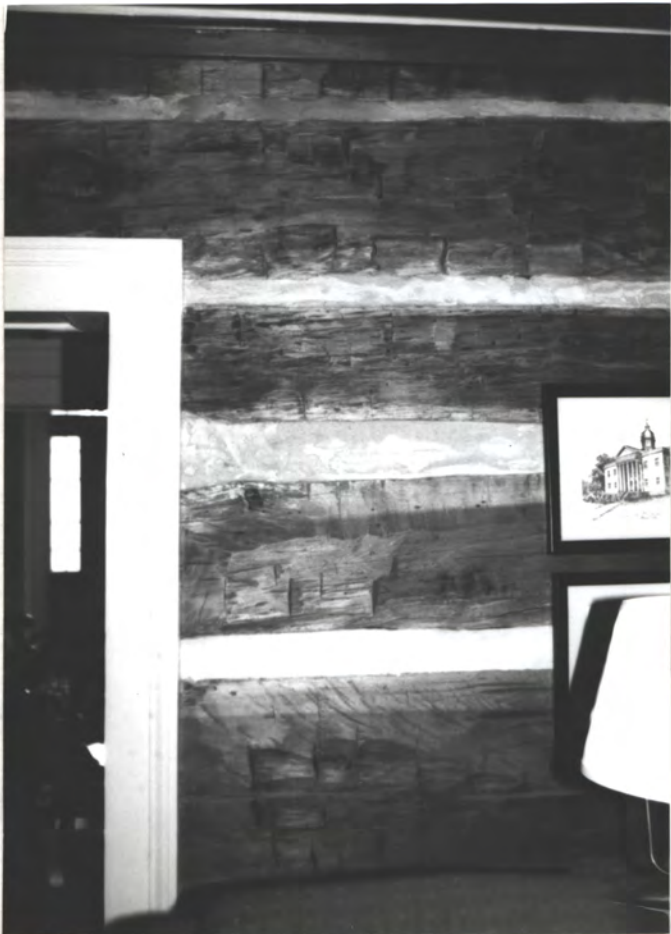

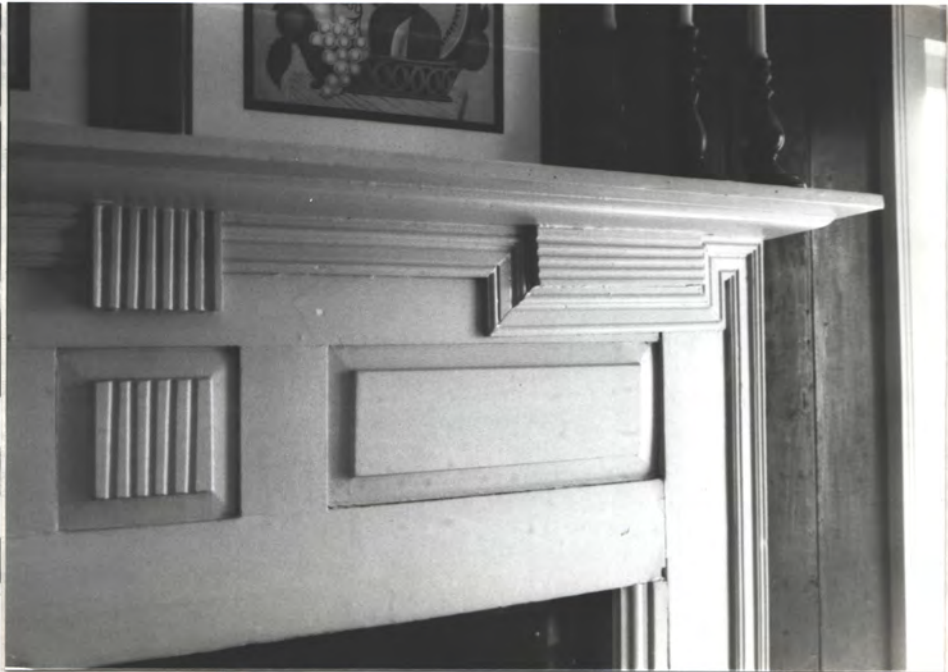
