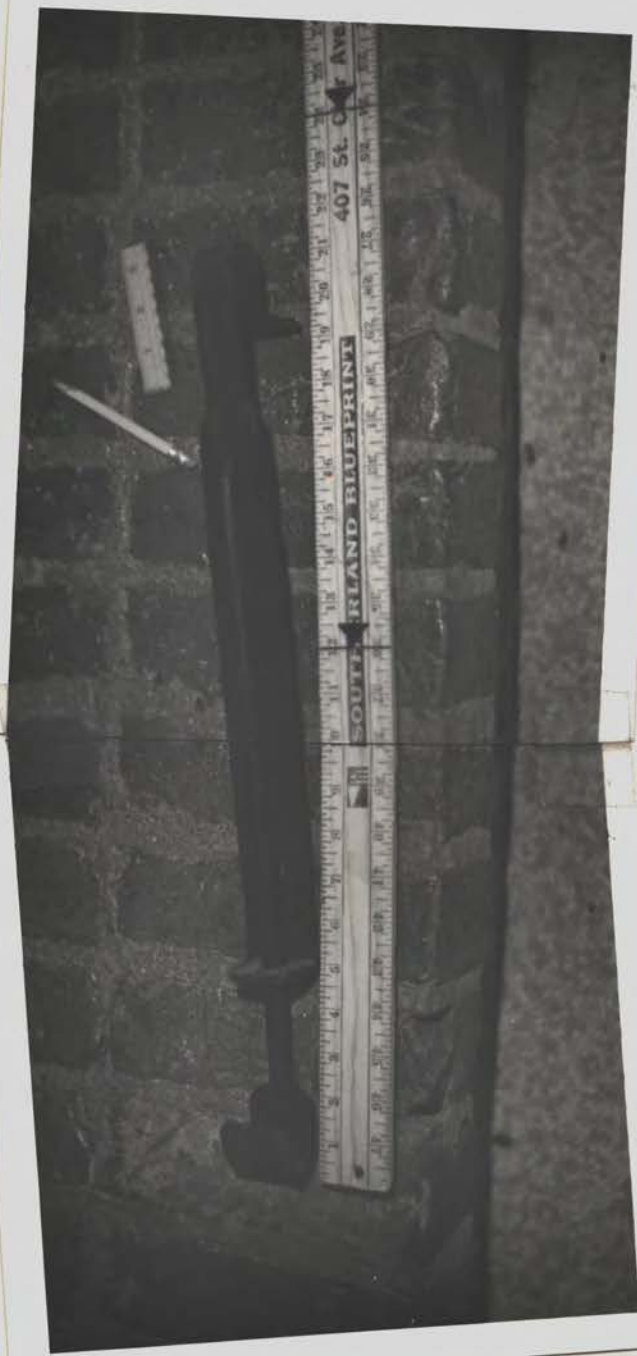

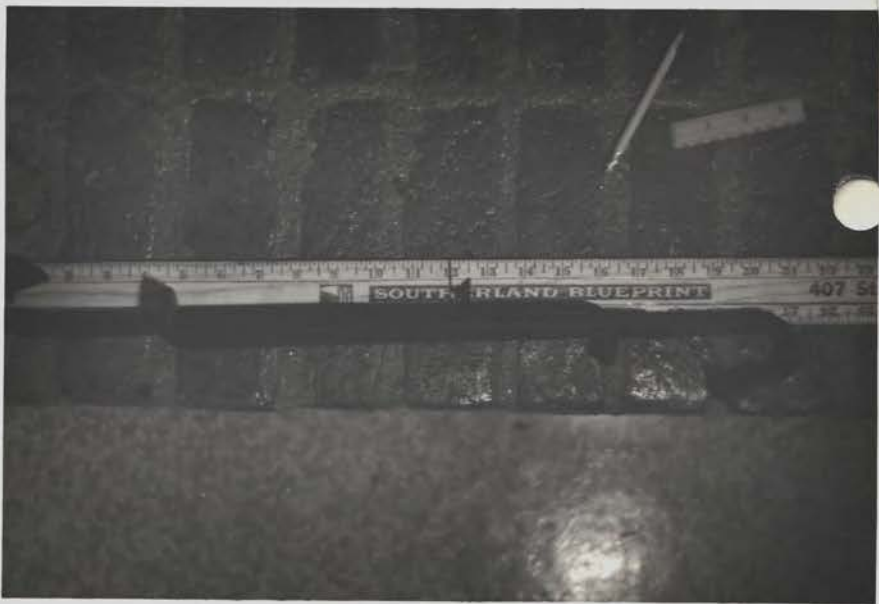

(on crane arms)

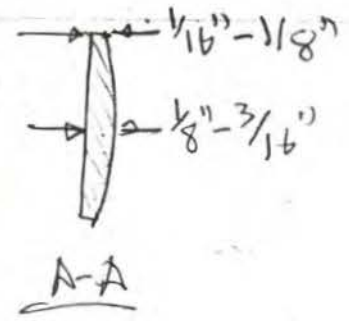
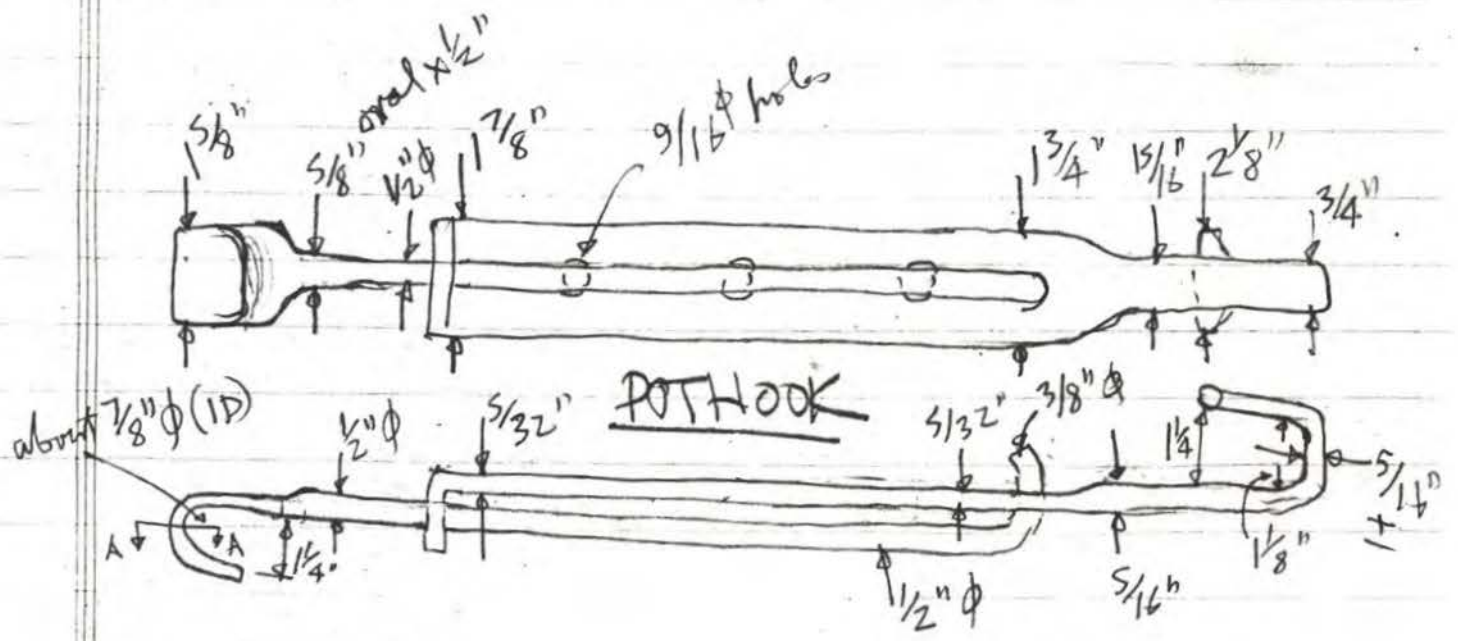
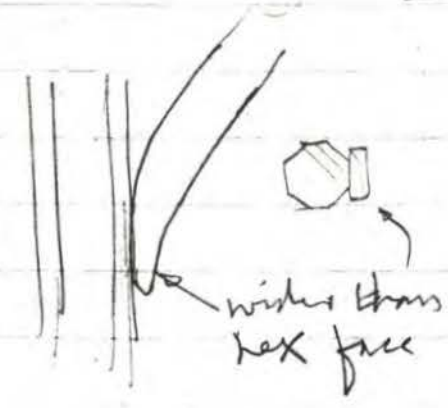
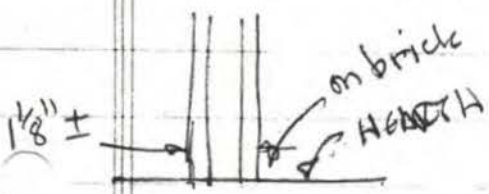
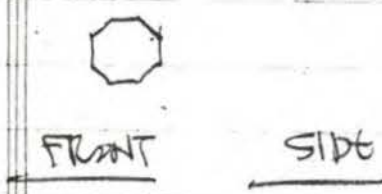
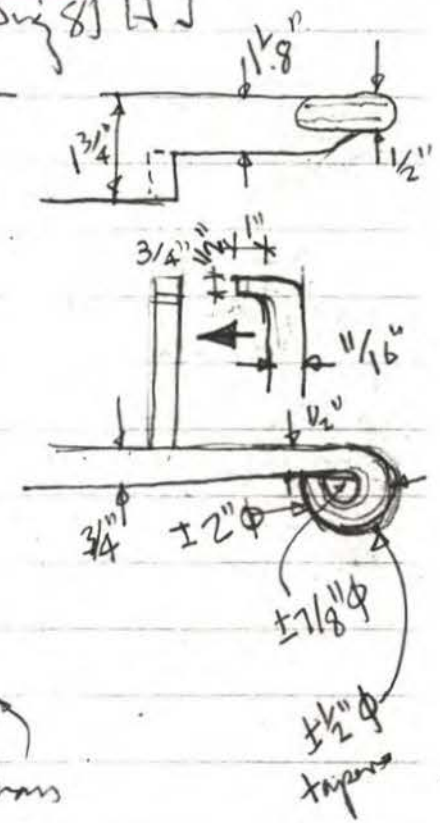
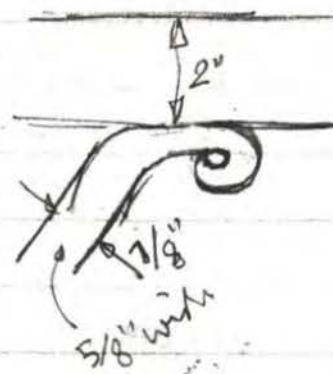
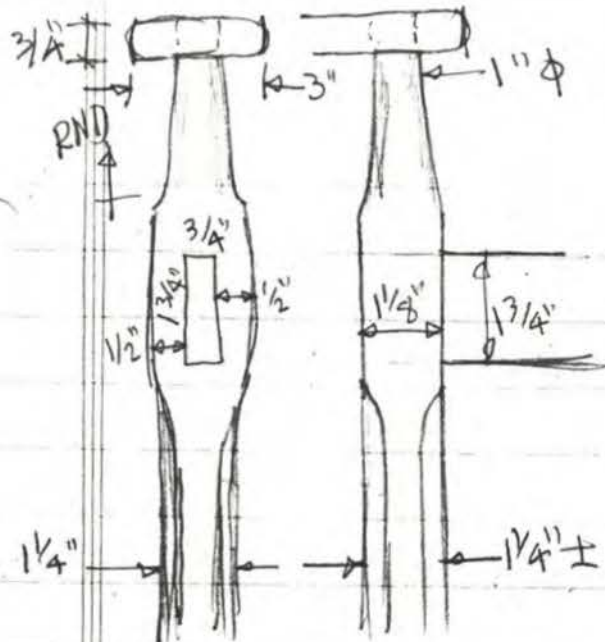

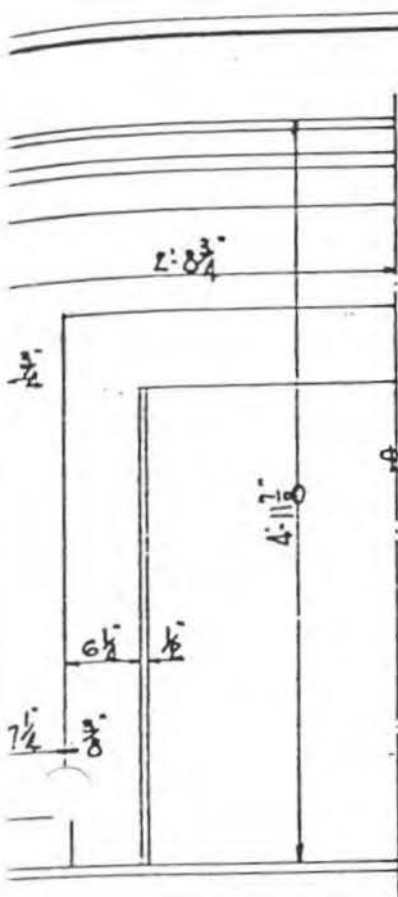

DETAILS OF KITCHEN FIREPLACE

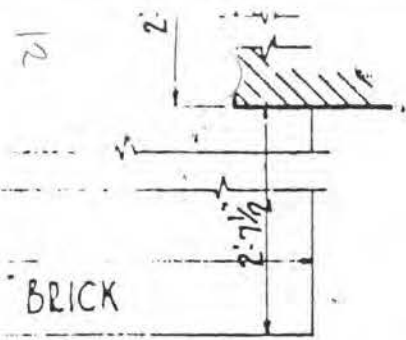

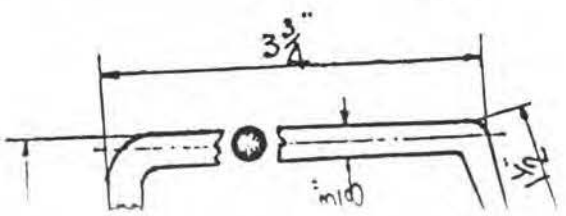
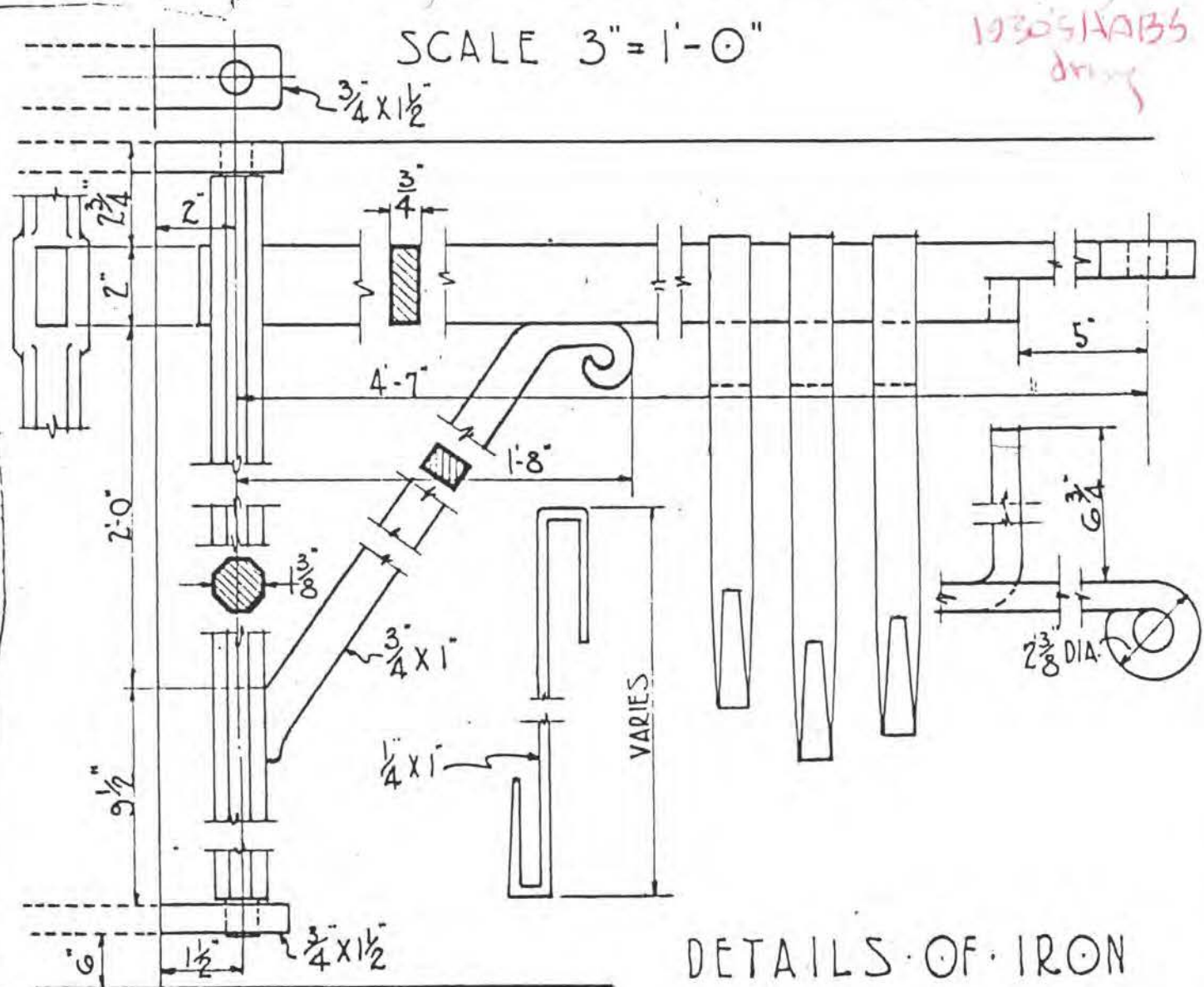
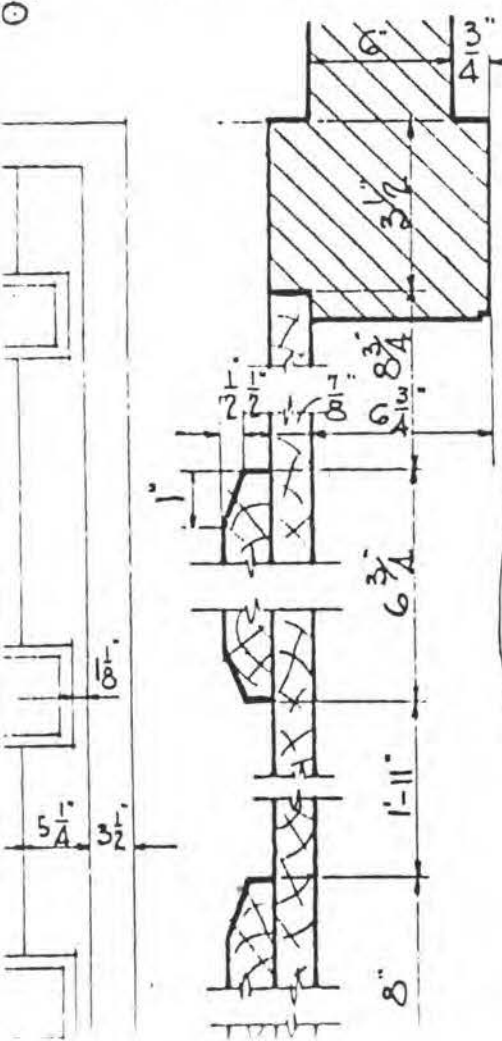
DETAILS OF LATCH ON KITCHEN DOOR

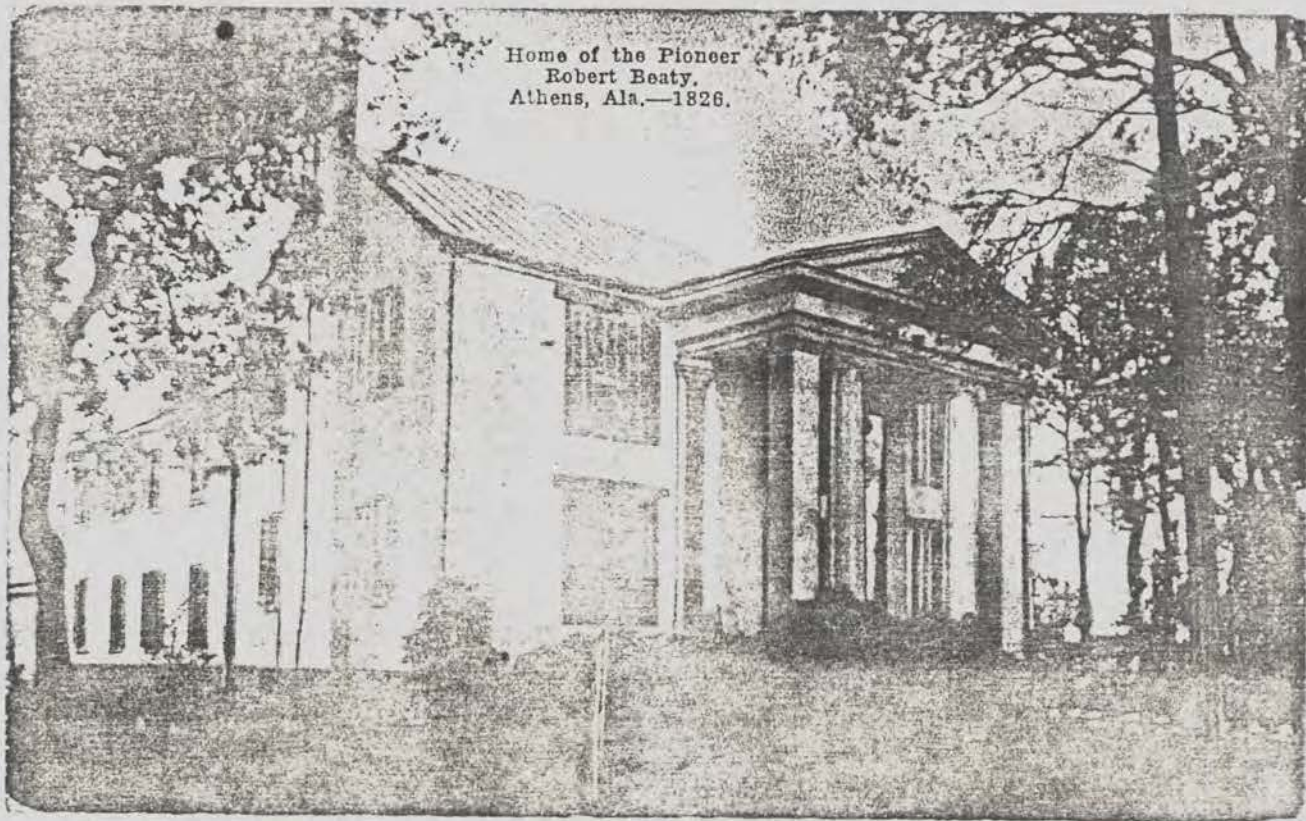


DETAILS OF IRON CRANE IN KITCHEN FIREPLACE
