

Dear Martha:

Attached is a memo dated 27 April '81 showing the various stages of the 1829 Miller House by the Central Presby. Ch. The Historic Commission meets at 4:30 PM on Dec. 14 (Mon.) at the Building Inspector's office on Madison St. (Parking Garage)

While I didn't bring it up yesterday, it continues to bother me to see the "bungalow bushes" on the landscape plans for the Weeden House. This type of planting,  was dominant in the Bungalow period & was not used in the 19th century, & so landscape historians have termed them "Bungalow bushes". To use them is the exact equivalent of putting Art Deco furniture & wallpaper in the Weeden House, for Art Deco & Bungalows is exactly contemporaneous.
