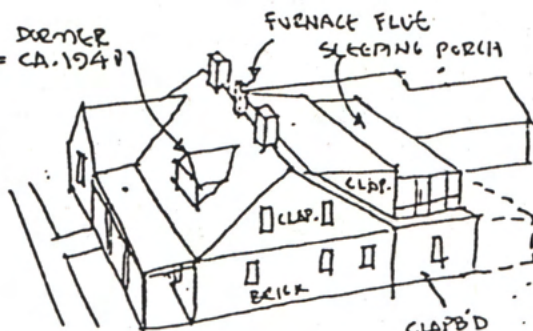
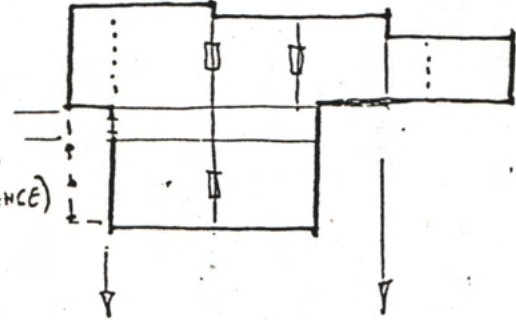


SIMILAR TO 1828 SHEPHERD HSE ON E. HOLMES, W/O VIC. PORCH

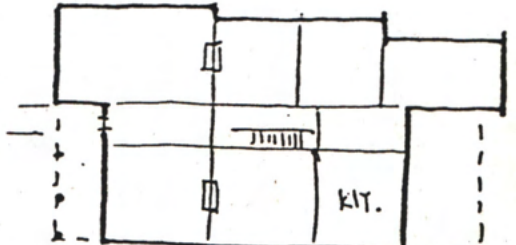
ORIGINAL PLAN
