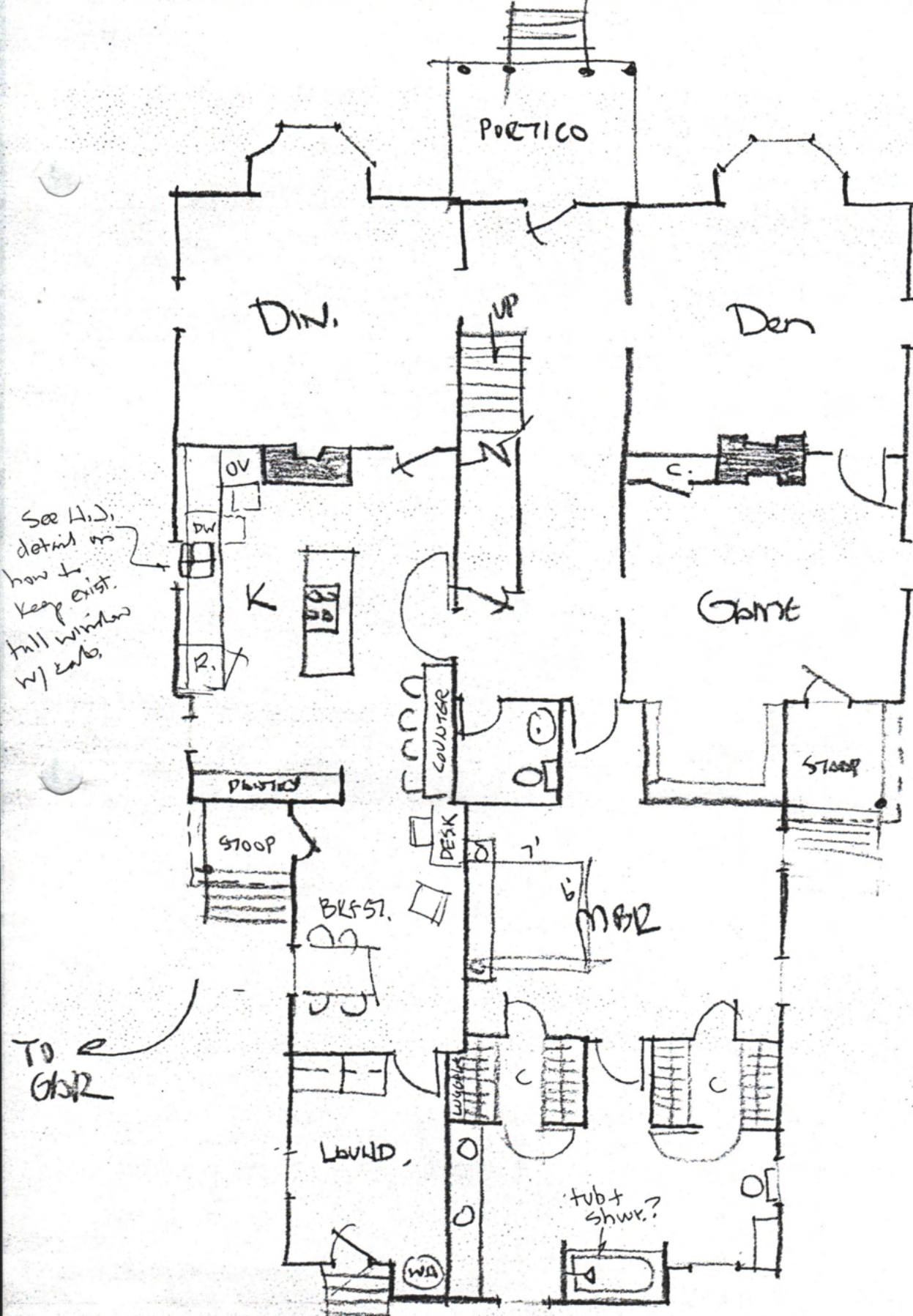
Dear Terry & Belinda —

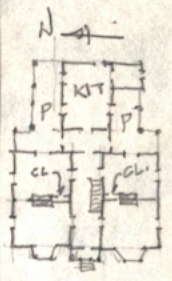


Unusual for the Victorian era is the perfect symmetry of this handsome Hazel Green house. A pair of tall, twin bay windows flanking the narrow porch is emphasized by a pair of twin chimneys punctuating the high roof. Fisher Oldfield, who oversaw construction, inspected each wagonload of lumber to verify that the yellow poplar wood was free of knots.
