

LOST IN SPACE?

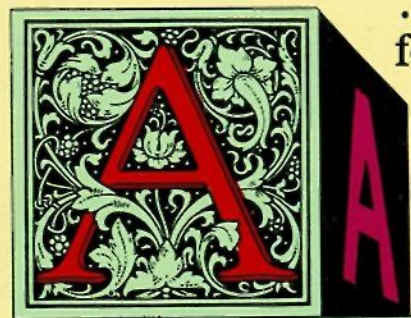

Be sure to sign the form in **BLOCK 18.**

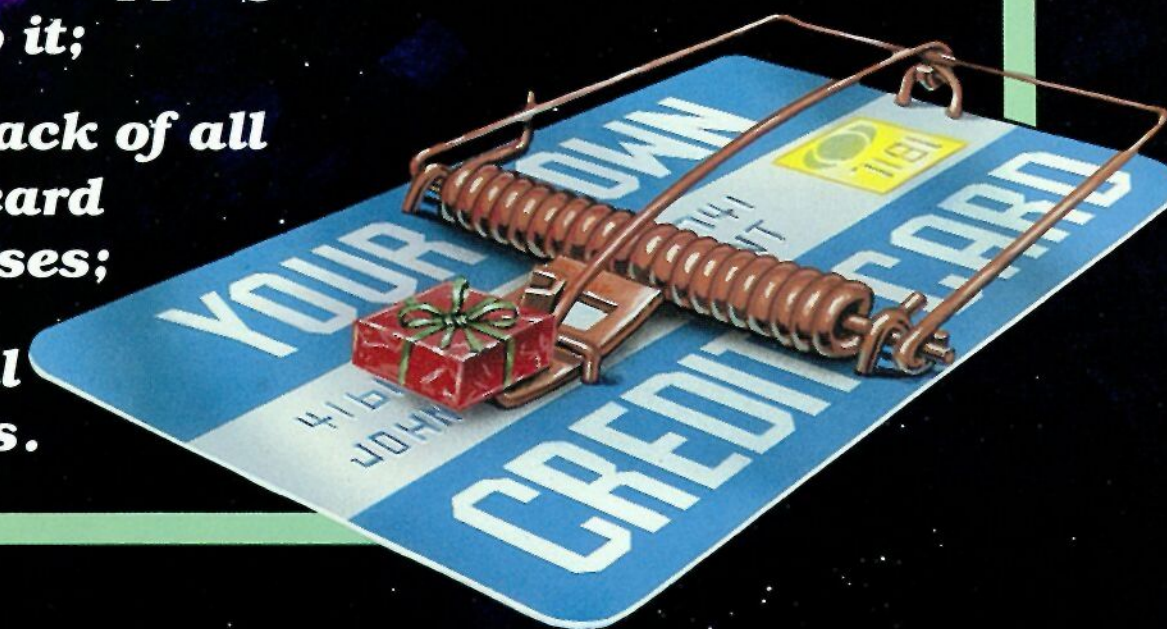


CLIP the itemized bill to the claim form OR have your health care provider complete & sign the bottom part of the form.
