MEMORANDUM For Dr. Lema/EM

I will be glad to see Professor Legadon provided you make it clear to him that I have so many matters pressing for my attention that I cannot stop to try to examine all the records or be responsible for giving from total recall a full and complete account of the matters raised in his questions. If he is prepared to ask me specific questions and, in the process, brief me a little as to those things he has found elsewhere which will enable me to fix on the specific matter he is asking about, I will be glad to see him and help him all I can. I think he must recognize that in my busy life I can help him most if he is prepared to give me what he has found from his research honestly and completely to the extent needed to get from me the gap-filling information which I may be in position to provide. I simply cannot go over the whole thing, trusting him to fill in his gaps.
