Dear Mr. Goldsmith:-

Mrs. Ida B. Dallas died at Nashville on October 12th, and in her will appointed me her sole executor and I have duly qualified as such in the County Court of Davidson County, Tennessee.

Fifty shares of the capital stock of the Huntsville Land Company stands on the books of that Company in Mrs. Dallas' name, and I have the certificates thereof in my possession.
