Know all men by these presents that we, William T. Hutchens and Andrew Murdock, partners under the firm name of Hutchens & Murdock, are justly indebted to the Huntsville Gas Light Company, a corporation under the laws of Alabama, in the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars as is shown by our five promissory notes of this date each for \$250 one of said notes falling due every six months until the last of the five is due, all payable at the First National Bank of Huntsville to the said Huntsville Gas Light Company, or order, and being anxious to secure the payment of said notes and in consideration thereof we bargain sell and transfer to the said Huntsville Gas Light Company the following described personal property to-wit: All of the materials, tools and machinery of the plumbing shop on Clinton Street in Huntsville, Alabama, which said property was sold by the Huntsville Gas Light Company to us on this day - and the debt hereby secured is part of the purchase money; - also, on all the materials, tools, goods and machinery now in the shop of the undersigned opposite or near Easley's Hotel in said City: also on any new supplies, tools, materials or machinery to be hereafter bought by us to be used in our plumbing business in Huntsville, Ala. and on all renewals of our said stock of materials, tools and machinery. All of the said property hereby mortgaged and now on hand is more fully described in an inventory thereof hereto attached marked A. This mortgage is made to secure said debt and if the same is paid as the notes described become due, then it is to be void and of no effect - but if we fail to pay any one of said notes when it is due, then the Huntsville Gas Light Company by its agents, is authorized to take possession of said property and after advertising the same for ten days by a notice in a newspaper published in Huntsville, to sell the same for cash to pay said debt. It is agreed that if we fail to pay any one of said notes for thirty days after it is due,

that the Huntsville Gas Light Company may at its option declare the entire debt secured hereby to be due and proceed to collect the same by foreclosure or other wise. When a sale is made under the power in this mortgage the proceeds of sale must be applied first to the costs of making the sale second to paying the debt secured by this mortgage including interest, and if a surplus is left it must be paid to the undersigned.
