

This contract made and entered into by and between
Hutchens & Murdock, parties of the first part, and the
Huntsville Ware-House Co, parties of the second part.

Witness^{that}; that where-as the said first parties
have agreed to install in the Five compartment ware-
houses belonging to the parties of the second part,
a complete system of Automatic Sprinklers, approved
by the Factory Insurance Association of Hartford Conn,
for the sum of Sixteen hundred and seventy four dollars
(\$1674.00) which sum, the said parties of the second
part agree to pay in the manner following,

To-wit: One third when two of the compartments are
fully equipped.

One third when all of the compartments are
fully equipped.

The balance when a thorough test has been
given to the system.

The parties of the first part agree to use the latest
improved Estey Sprinklers head, and to install said
plant in a thorough and working^{like} manner, according to
the specifications and plans furnished by said Factory
Insurance Association.

All material to be of standard quality.

It is further understood and agreed that the work of
the installation of this plant shall commence forth-
with, and the first^{two} compartment^s shall be completed so
that water may be turned upon them not later than
December 1st, 1895. All the balance of the work to
be completed not later than January 1st, 1896. unless
prevented by unavoidable accidents, ^{beyond the} ~~to be under~~ control
of the parties of the first part.

The said first parties agree to furnish all material and
^{install} ~~direct~~ all the necessary pipes, fittings, hangers,

sprinkler heads and all other material necessary for the complete installation of the Sprinkler system.

Taking the water supply from the tank located in the tower of the West Huntsville Cotton Mills, by a 6 inch pipe, to be connected with the system as shown on the plant. *Branch line to 12 ft instead of*

50 ft from Bell

It is understood that the water supply for each compartment is to be separately cut off by an Indicator Gate Valve.

It is further understood and agreed that there shall be a draw off valve at the bottom of each riser in each compartment

so that the system may be thoroughly drained when necessary.

It is also further understood and agreed by the party of the first part, that they are to do all excavating and back filling required to lay the cast iron pipe which is to be laid at a depth of below the Frost mark.

It is further understood by the parties of the first part that cut off valves from each compartment shall be located at least 12 feet distance from the plant.
