

IN MEMORIAM.

Mary Elizabeth Newman, wife of the late Dr. Francis H. Newman, was born in Hanover county, Virginia, September 17, 1817; died in Huntsville, Alabama, on the evening of December 19, 1878.

The deceased was one of the only two children raised, both of the same age, of Captain William Powers, who served his country in the war of 1812.

The deceased came to Alabama, in infancy, married young and, shortly after her marriage, connected herself with the Methodist Church, which connection she continued during her life. She was a mother of thirteen children, of whom there are eleven surviving.

Those who knew her at home through life bear profoundly grateful and reverential tribute to her memory. She knew well that a true wife is man's reasonable companion, to assist him in the toils of life, to soothe him with her tenderness and recompense him with womanly love.

Those who called her mother were ever happy in that right. She commanded with that judgment which springs from deep maternal interest, and was obeyed. The care of her family was her whole delight, and she taught the simple law of love.

Her children she regarded as sweet pledges of a mutual and endeared affection. In her death they have lost more than can ever be supplied.
