R. J. Manning issued this fractional note to assist him in making change in his business as a Huntsville merchant. His store flourished during the 1830's, carrying groceries, wines and liquors.

R. J. Manning served as alderman of Huntsville in 1837 and 1838, entering that office at the age of 33.
