This is a reproduction of a \$2 bill issued by the Huntsville Hotel Company during the period when Alabama was a member of the Confederacy. Built in 1858, the Huntsville Hotel occupied the northwest corner of Spring and Jefferson Streets, the site presently occupied by the Henderson National Bank. The Huntsville Hotel was destroyed by fire in 1910. This bill is reprinted as a public service by the Henderson National Bank in commemoration of Alabama's 150th anniversary of statehood.
