Dear Mr. Nichols:

As you are probably aware by this time, the general court-martial case of United States vs. Colonel John C. Nickerson, Jr. has been postponed, at defense request, until 25 June 1957.

The defense has requested the undersigned, and the Commanding General, this headquarters, to secure your presence at this trial. It appears that your presence will be required, based upon this defense request. While a definite date for your appearance has not yet been determined, it is requested that you make arrangements which will allow you to be available during the period from approximately 1 to 17 July 1957.

The defense is being asked to furnish a definite appearance date for you. The length of your stay at Redstone Arsenal will be determined to a large degree by this appearance date to be furnished by the defense.

You are being summoned at the request of the defense as defense witnesses, though I, the prosecutor, am legally charged with the responsibility of securing your presence. Accordingly, your cooperation in this matter will be appreciated. At the earliest possible time, a subpoena, requiring your presence at Redstone Arsenal on a specified date, and witness mileage and allowances will be forwarded to you.
