STIPULATION

It is hereby stipulated by and between the Prosecution and the Defense, with the express consent of the accused, that if Brigadier General A. J. Kinney were present in court and sworn as a witness for the Prosecution, he would testify as follows:

My name is Brigadier General A. J. Kinney and I am now and was during the month of December 1956, the Director, Office of Information Services, Department of the Air Force. Shortly before Christmas 1956 I had occasion to see a Mr. Jack Anderson, an associate of Mr. Drew Pearson, in my office at the Pentagon, Washington, D. C. Mr. Anderson, during the course of this interview, handed a document entitled, "Considerations on the Wilson Memorandum," to me and asked for comment. My attention at the moment was directed at the other subject of inquiry and I placed this document to one side. Shortly, the interview was concluded and Mr. Anderson departed leaving this document "Considerations on the Wilson Memorandum" behind. Whether this was intentional or inadvertant I do not know. After Mr. Anderson had departed, I noticed the document he had handed me and which he had left behind. Thereafter, I examined and read this document entitled "Considerations on the Wilson Memorandum." Prosecution Exhibit No. is that document which was left with me by Mr. Jack Anderson shortly before Christmas 1956. I recognize it by its general appearance, its size and format, its content, the letters "JA" appearing thereon, and by the edges of the document where it appears as if something was stuck there and then pulled off. The document I received from Mr. Anderson had the same appearance and the same initials appearing thereon. There were no classification markings on this document I received nor are there any on Prosecution Exhibit No. . .
