unbearable personal losses, and injury  
for the rest of my life, at the hands  
of the Iron hand of a military clique.  
Who barred me from hiring local  
attorneys to present my Case before (Hill?)  
Labor relations hearings, wherein I was  
denied promotion which I was justly

entitled to, as a Civilian Employee with 6 years  
and one months Continuous extension duty  
without leave from my Station of duty,

after local justice had miserably failed,  
and my Case was heard for three separate  
hearings, without an attorney being present  
to present my Case, wherein in each Case  
a different attorney had agreed to be  
present and to defend me.

all of whom failed to appear at said  
hearings? after each one had held my  
papers + information in his file Case  
for 8 Days previous to each separate  
Labor relation hearing, no one appeared,

I was then desperate, hence I appealed to  
Washington for help, by Reg air Mail  
return Card attached.

This letter was received, by opposition to the  
Case of justice, by conspiracy, with no record  
as to who received the same.

I was immediately given my examination,  
and relieved of my permanent Civil Service
