1. a. Pursuant to directions contained in SO 114, AG Ala. 17 June 1949 all units Alabama National Guard, less rear dets, will proceed from Fort Benning Georgia to home stations on 23 July 1949 according to march tables appended hereto as Annex No. 2.

1. Rear dets will depart for home stations upon completion of duties at this station. Time of departure this station will be governed by requirement that rear dets must arrive home station not earlier than 0001 hrs 25 July and not later than 2400 hrs same date. Rear dets will observe regulations as to speed and conduct published in annexes to this march order.

b. Travel will be performed by U.S. Govt motor vehicle. TPA not authorized.

c. Messing facilities not being available EM only are authorized to obtain meals on a credit basis from civilian sources. All Units auth breakfast 24 July at cost not to exceed 80¢ per EM. March units Nos 1, 2, & 3 auth to obtain a hot meal enroute at cost not to exceed 85¢. Invoices for meals (quadruplicate) will be completely filled in, signed in ink, and mailed to USP & DO, Ala., PO Box 1311, Montgomery, Ala. within 24 hrs after arrival home station. (Meal invoices attchd).

d. Travel directed is necessary in the military service.
