SUBJECT: REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER QUARTER

No doubt you are aware of the fact that the University of Alabama has been directed to admit one Negro student at the main campus and one at the Huntsville Center this summer.

Plans are being made now to assure a. that the academic program will proceed smoothly, b. that all persons and property will be protected. However, these plans will involve some inconvenience to you. We urge your patience, understanding, and full cooperation.

As soon as plans are completed, we shall make every effort to inform you of their details. You are requested to check the Center bulletin boards, local newspapers, and television and radio broadcasts for current announcements.

It is essential that only authorized persons come to the Center at time of registration; therefore, some means of student identification is necessary. For the convenience of present students who plan to attend during the summer term, the Center staff is prepared to issue identification cards before the end of the present quarter. In order that these cards may be issued, it will be necessary for those of you who wish to enroll this summer to complete the attached statement and submit it to your instructors tonight.

Identification cards will be prepared for all persons who sign and submit this statement. These cards should be picked up in Room 106 between 5:00 and 8:00 p.m. during examination week, June 3 - 7. If you do not pick up your card during this period, it will result in considerable additional inconvenience to you at registration.
